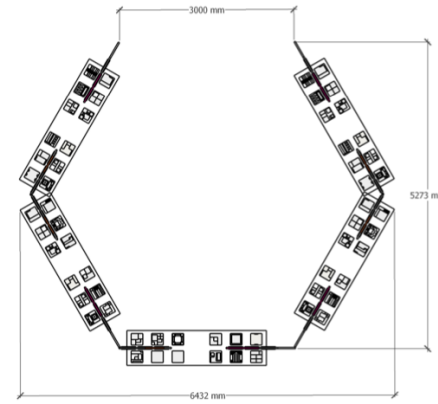
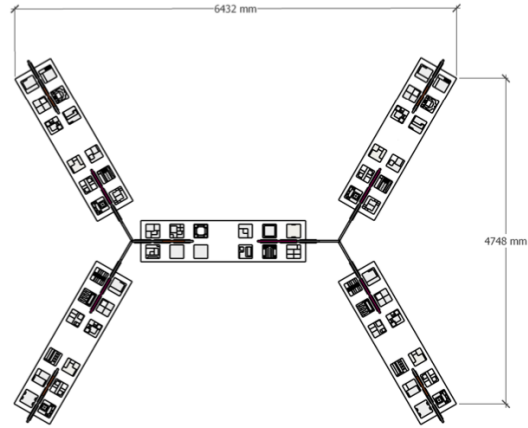


Isometric

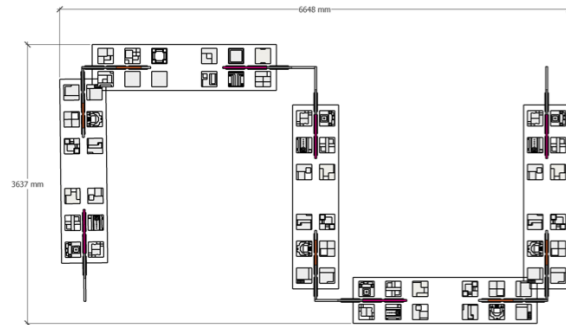

INTER-COMMITTEE WORKSHOP

ACYA-ACSR

PHASE ONE On-site Exploration April 26-29 ,2025

This phase has provided participants with direct, immersive experiences into the work of **architects in Thailand** who are engaged with marginalized communities.

Attendees has explored **methodologies, design processes, and the tangible social impacts** of community-centered architectural practices.

PHASE TWO Online Knowledge Sharing June -July ,2025

Upon returning to their home countries, participants will connect with local architects involved in similar work from their context.

They will gather case studies, methodologies, and community impacts to be shared in an online platform. This phase aims to build a **knowledge base and foster a transnational network of architects working with marginalized communities.**



E- PUBLICATION

PHASE THREE Youth Engagement and Knowledge Dissemination

The final phase will aim to involve young architects, preferably through the **ACYA (ARCASIA Committee of Young Architects)**, in spreading the acquired knowledge.

This will help raise awareness, inspire interest, and nurture a new generation of socially responsible architects across the region.
