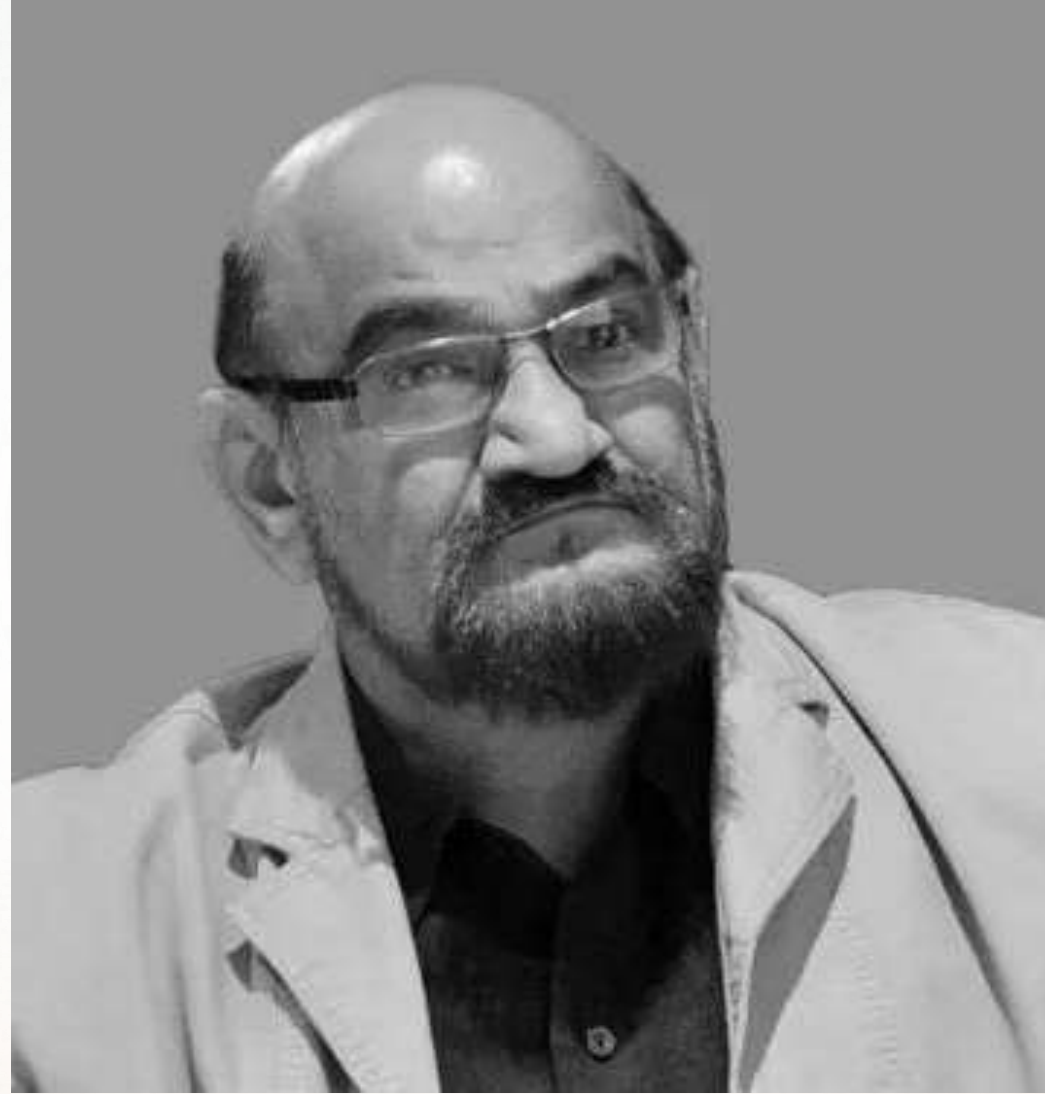
Visa Support for ARCASIA 2025 – India

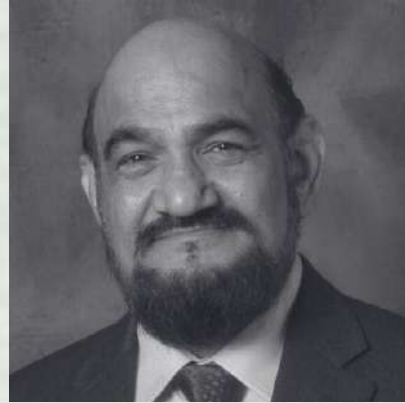
