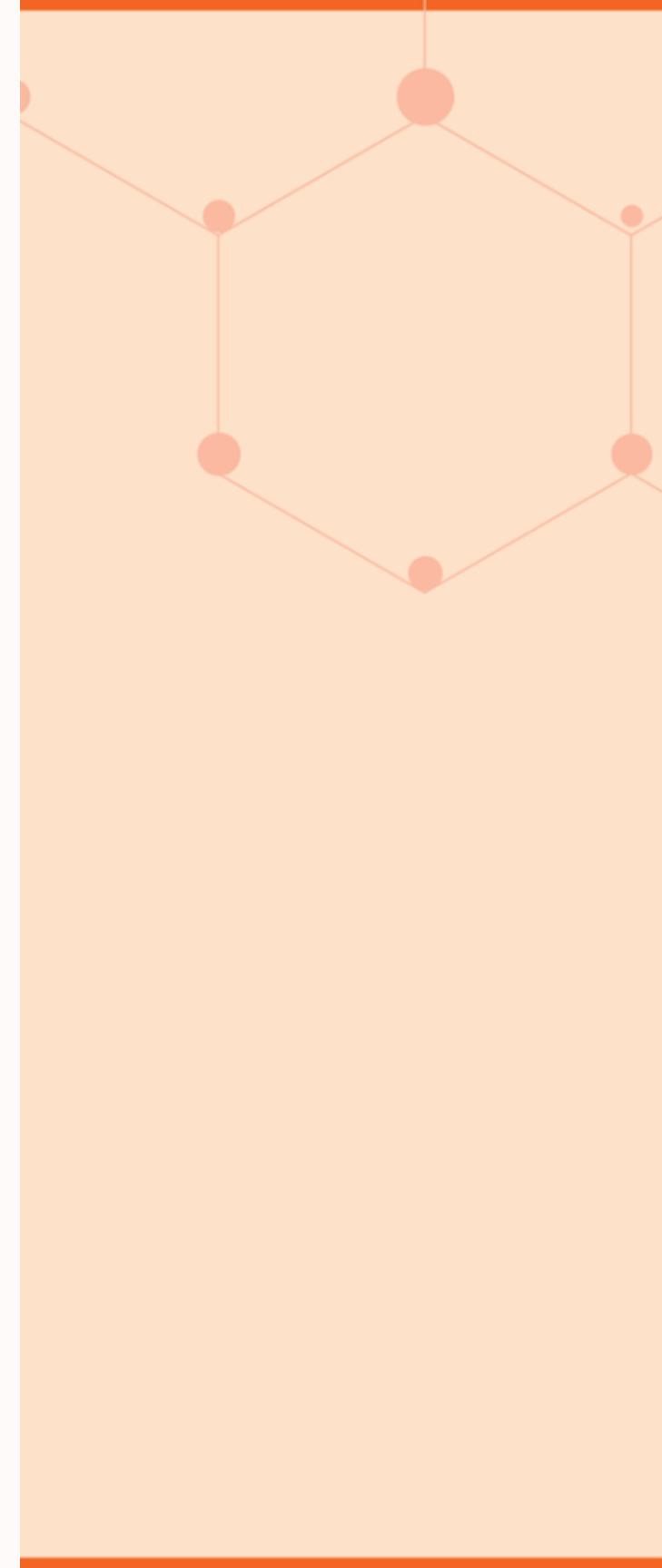

Organizational Strength

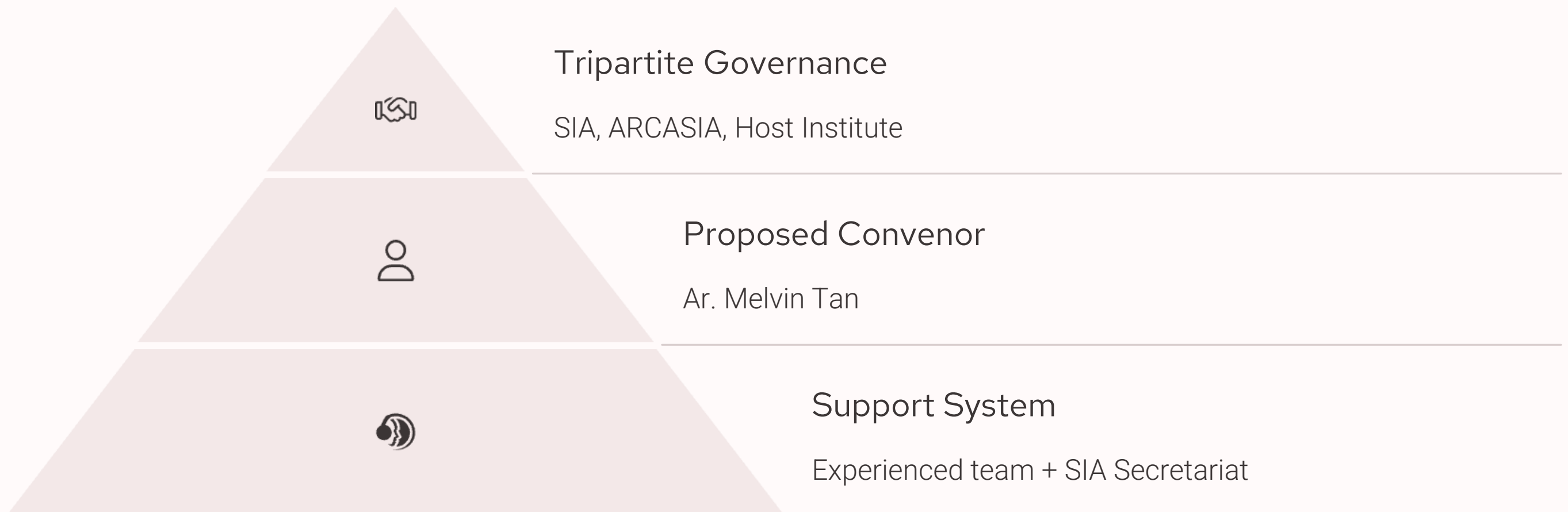
Our robust secretariat provides comprehensive support for high-profile events, ensuring seamless coordination and professional execution of complex award programs with multiple stakeholders.

Five-member panel including the ARCASIA President, one Singapore non-architect representative, and three eminent architects, providing diverse expertise and balanced evaluation.

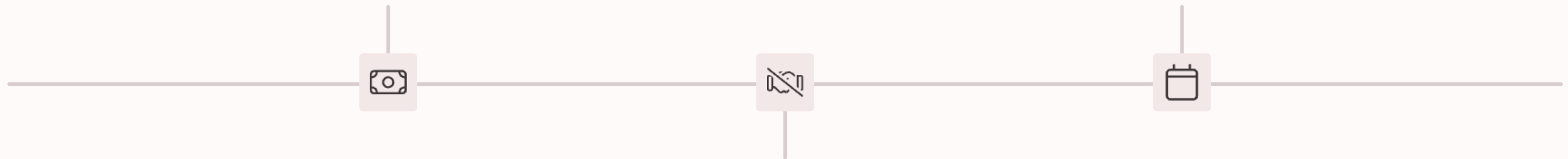




Financial Management & Timeline

Financial Model

Option 1:

- Arcasia pays SIA a fee of US\$20,000 annually to run AAA
- Arcasia seeks sponsorship
- Arcasia takes 100% of sponsorship

Option 2:

- Arcasia pays SIA a fee of US\$20,000 annually to run AAA
- SIA seeks sponsorship
- Arcasia takes first US\$20,000 of any sponsorship value
- Beyond first US\$20,000, SIA and Arcasia 50/50 split

This model includes comprehensive in-person final judging with international jury travel, providing the highest level of interaction and deliberation quality.
