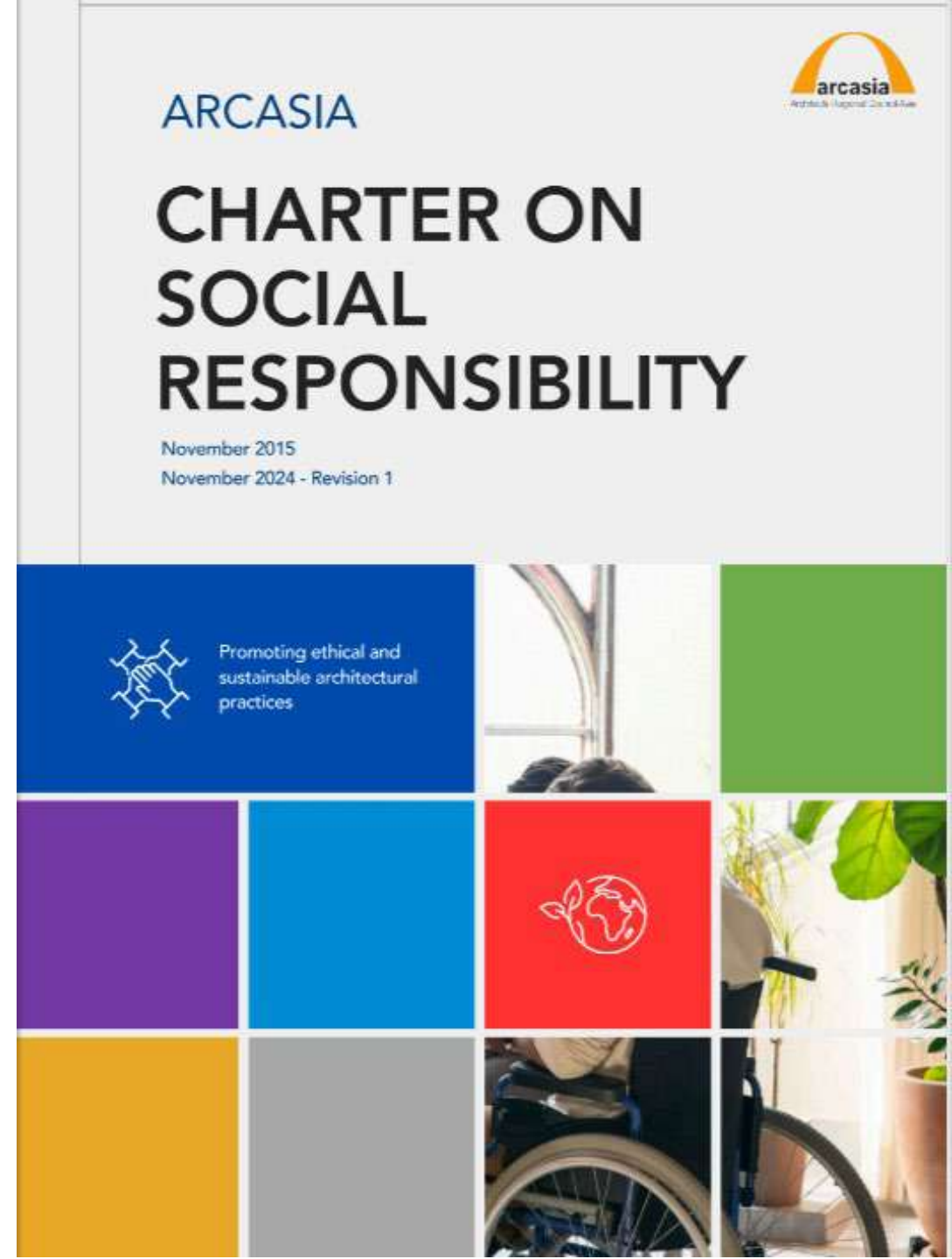

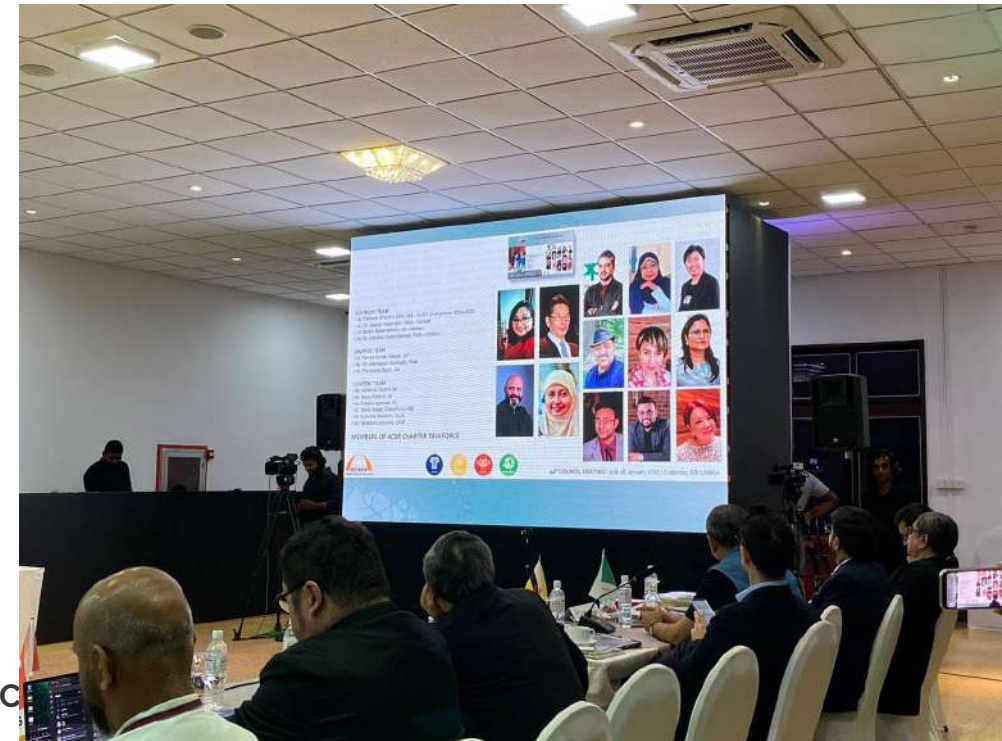
THE NEW EDITION OF THE ACSR CHARTER

The ARCASIA Committee on Social Responsibility (ACSR) Charter, also known as the ACSR Charter, was launched unofficially on 14 January 2025 during the ACSR Committee Meeting in Colombo, Sri Lanka.

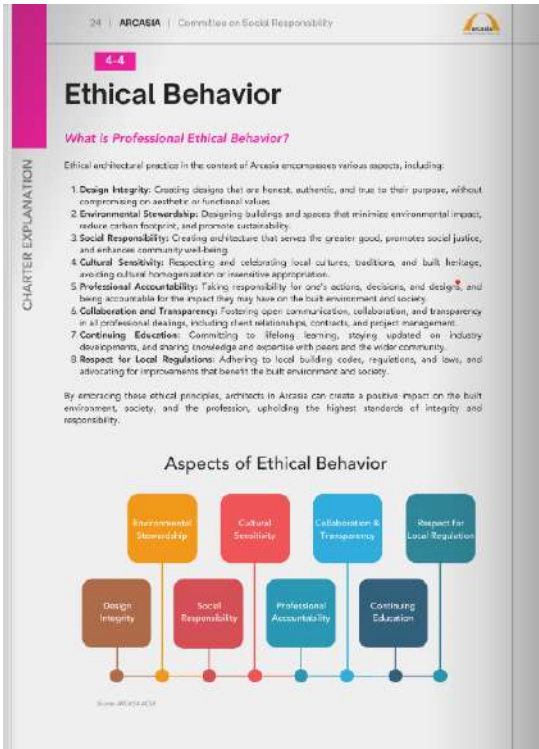


ACSR Charter Taskforce aimed to create a contemporary, accessible, and impactful document that will serve future generations effectively.



The efforts of the taskforce were focused on enhancing the charter to make it more user-friendly and appealing. Key updates include:

- **Improved Format:** Summaries, infographics, and color-coded chapters were incorporated to enhance accessibility.
- **Expanded Examples:** Recent award-winning projects and initiatives were added, highlighting the mission and vision of social responsibility.
- **Preservation of Core Content:** All original chapters have been retained, ensuring the document remains true to its foundational values.



Originally established in 2015, the ACSR Charter has served as the guiding principle for all ACSR activities.

Recognizing the need for a more engaging and adaptable version for the younger generation, the revised edition now includes:

- Colour coding
- Short notes
- Infographics
- Updated examples
- Enhanced graphical representation

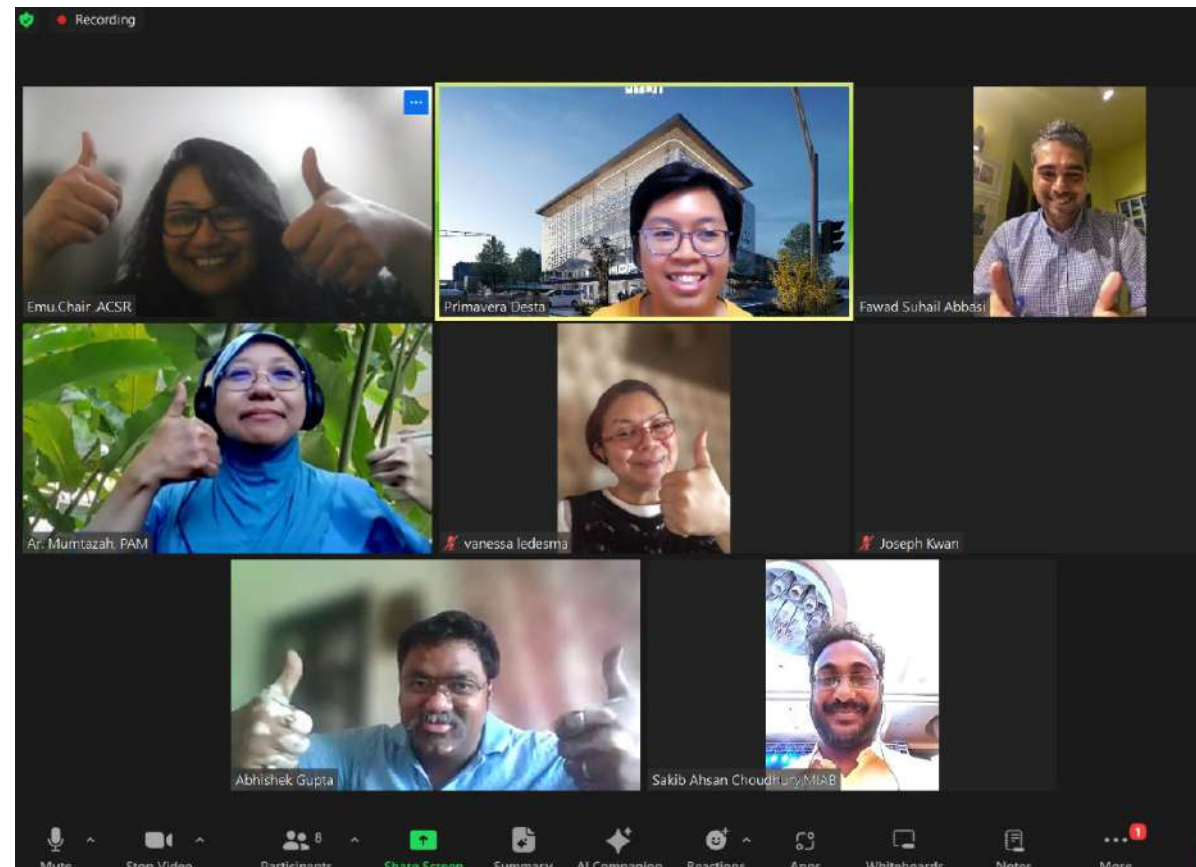

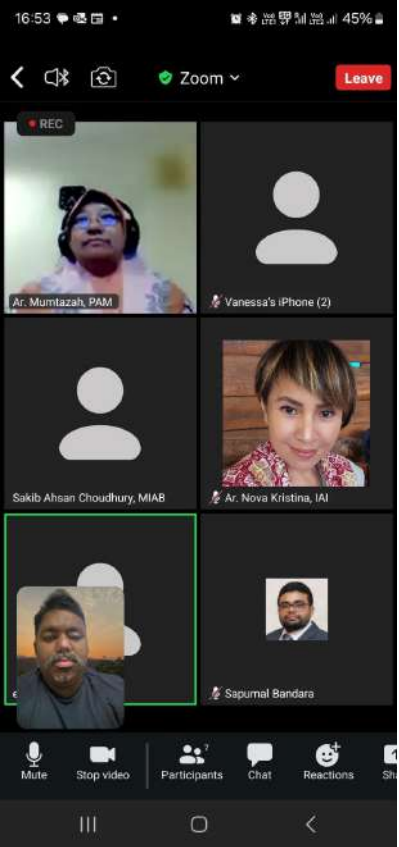

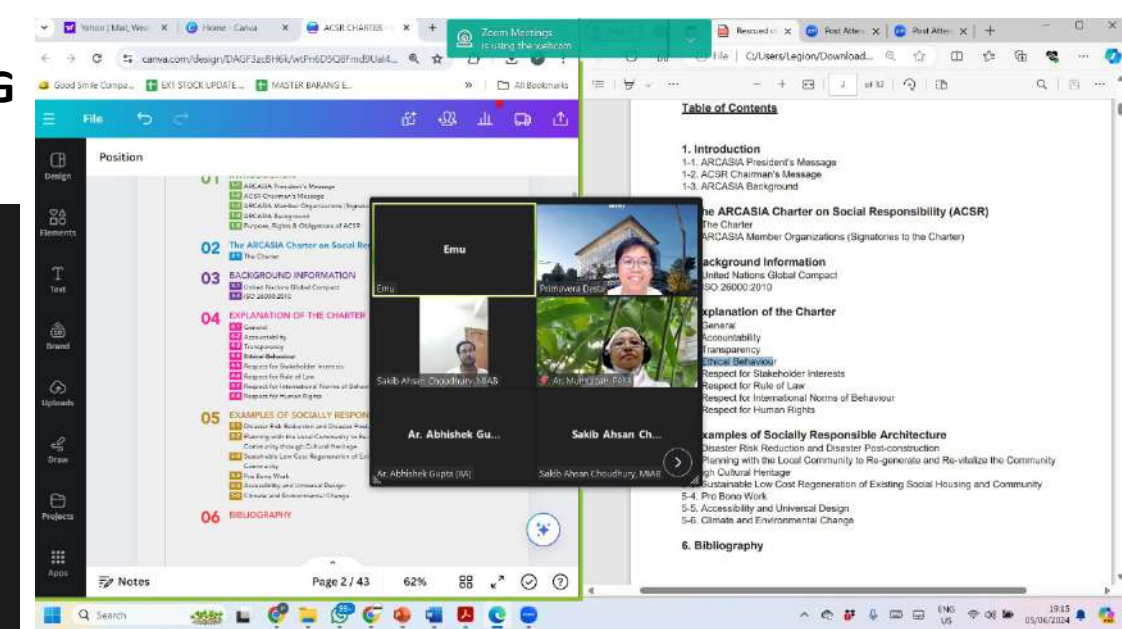
