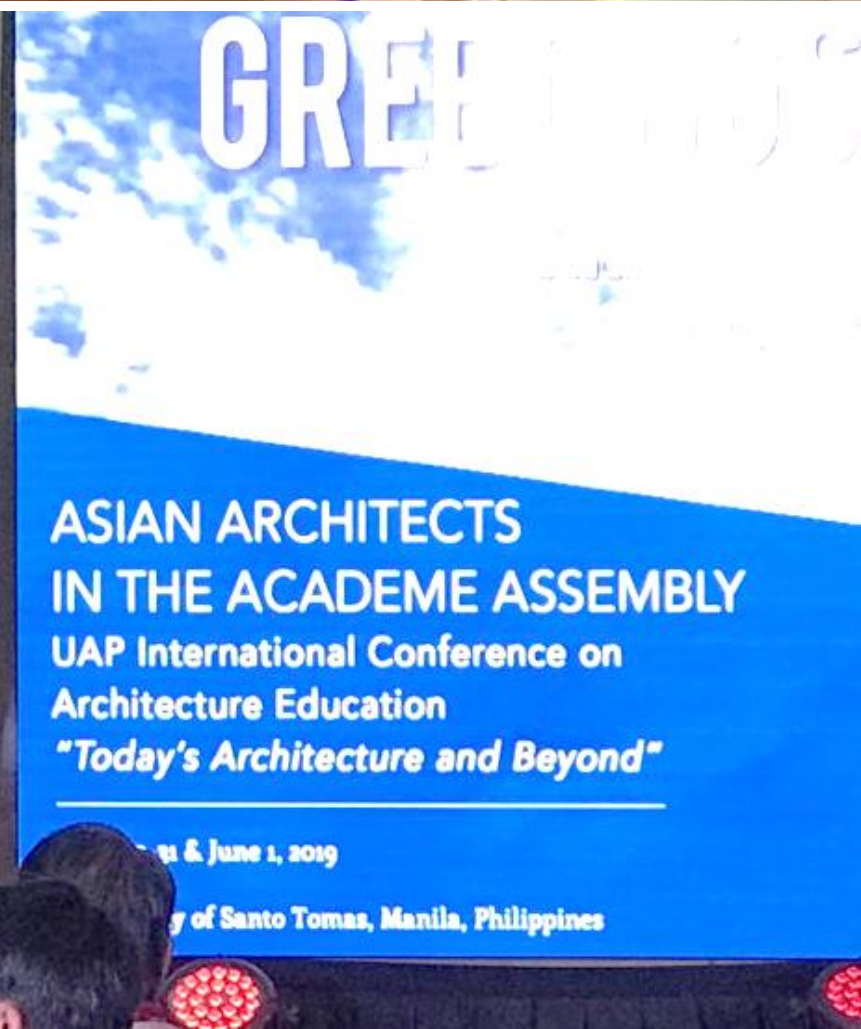

She commenced her career at Mimarlar & Han Tümertekin, one of the most prominent and awarded design firm in Turkey. Her celebrated and much-awarded practice, founded a few years later, specializes in design work across scales including single-family homes, housing projects, boutique hotel buildings, architectural restoration projects, and modern office buildings in a variety of contexts like historic quarters, redeveloping districts, and recently-designed neighborhoods. Hayriye undertakes professional service enthusiastically, actively participating as a visiting instructor and design critic at the prestigious Istanbul Technical University and Yıldız Technical University. One of her recent projects, Protel Office Building was nominated for the Aga Khan Award in 2016 and EU Mies Award in 2017.
