She then took over as Chair of the Australian Sustainable Built Environment Council (ASBEC) and continues as Member of the Australian Building Codes Board (ABCB).

Caroline has and continues to be involved in academia. She tutored briefly at Sydney University before taking up a full time position at the University of Newcastle from 1993 to 1997. She continues to contribute to various academic institutions around the country, especially with regard to her design approach to ESD. She was appointed to adjunct Professor of Architecture at the Faculty of the Built Environment of the University of NSW in June 2004.
