COMPOSITION OF THE COUNCIL

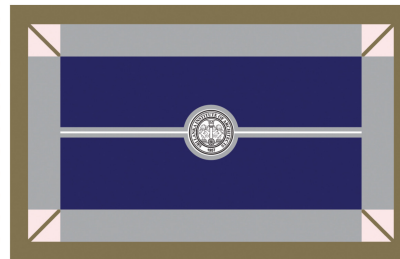
The Council consists of a total of (20) Twenty Members comprising Eight (08) Office Bearers and Four (04) Chairmen of Boards dealing with Education, Professional Affairs, Publications and Management; who are elected for a term of two years whilst the balance members numbering eight are elected each year. The present Council was appointed in February 2021 and will be in office till February 2022 but the office bearers will continue until February 2023.

The Sri Lanka Institute of Architects (SLIA) was formed on 17th September 1957, with a Constitution for functioning on the model of the Royal Institute of British Architects (RIBA).

The Institute was incorporated under the “Sri Lanka Institute of Architects Law No. 1 of 1976”, enacted by the National State Assembly of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka .

The above Act was amended in 1996 paving the way to create an Architects Registration Board with powers to register persons qualified to practice the Profession of Architecture in Sri Lanka.

With the current pandemic situation The Sri Lanka Institute of Architects successfully conducted the first ever Architects National Conference in Digital Platform on 18th February 2021.

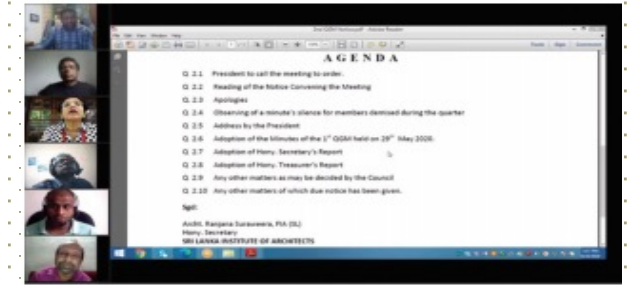
Annual General Meeting

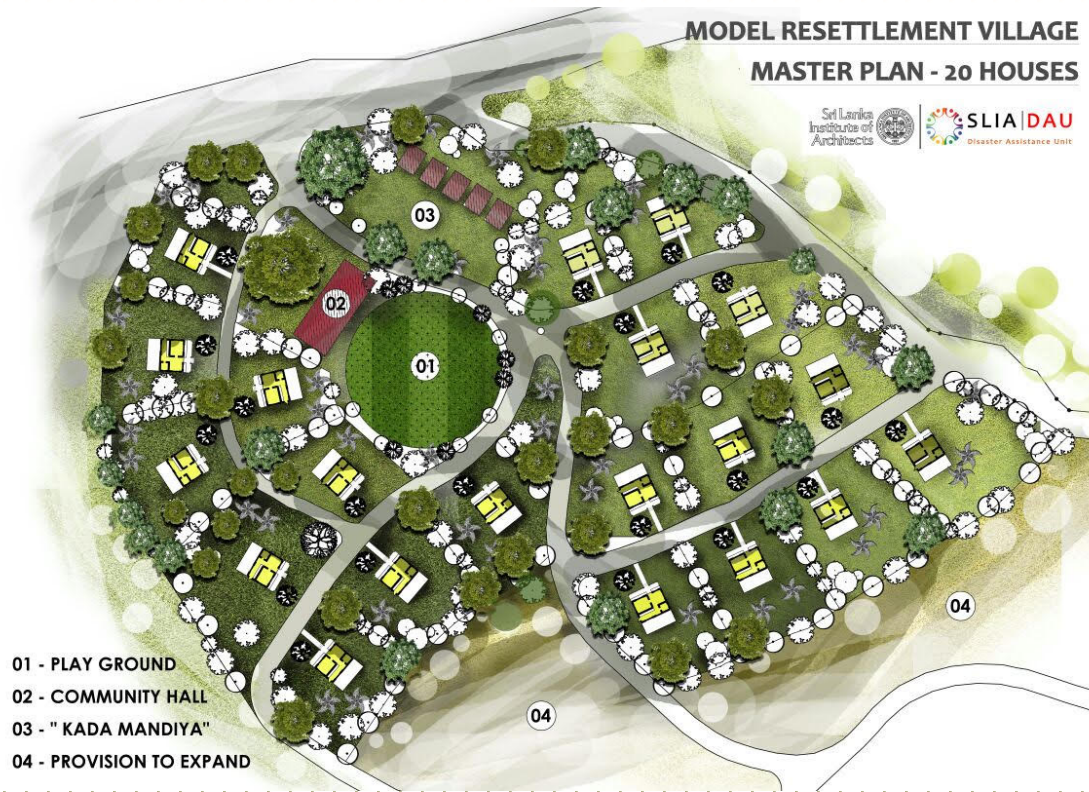

TOILET BLOCKS FOR SCHOOLS

The scheme looks at creating a comfortable and pleasant experience for students who make use of the toilets. A functional approach of having a well-ventilated, naturally lit building helps to maintain hygiene, with the use of materials and efficient servicing facilitates for easy maintenance.

The building is designed with the intention of incorporating solar panels on the larger portion of the roof; the building thereby tries to go beyond just being a mere toilet block. Two layout options have been explored allowing the orientation of the building to be changed while modifying just the entrance portion.

The building is meant to be seamlessly incorporated, and to thereby uplift the built fabric of existing needy schools. The use of soft landscaping in the form of short trees and flowering plants in the vicinity of the building facilitates this further. Maintaining the plants and trees could be an opportunity for students to get involved in a culture which overflows on to the rest of the school and eventually brings about a strong sense of belonging.

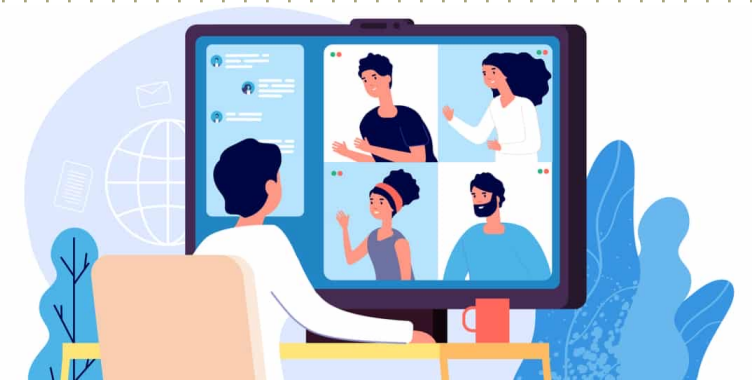

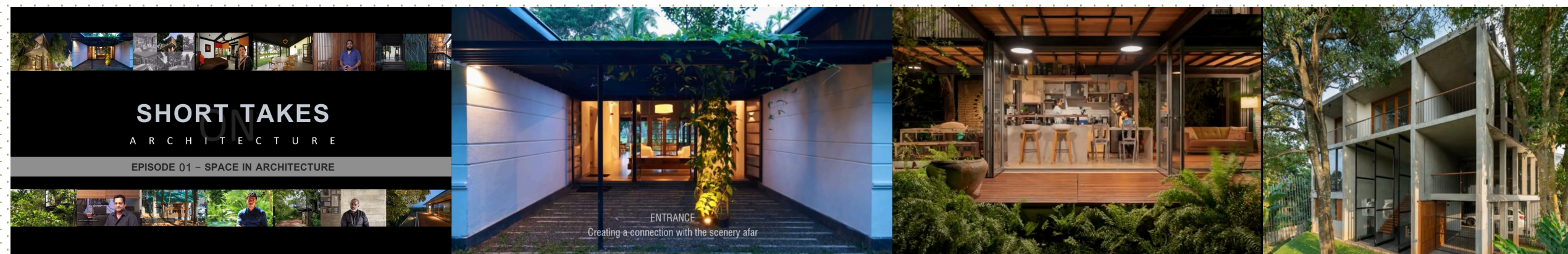
SLIA established a benevolent fund for its membership, modalities of benefit and replenishment and continued enhancement of the fund are currently being finalized
