 Series of 2021

ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATE OF ACCREDITATION TO THE UNITED ARCHITECTS OF THE PHILIPPINES, INC. AS THE ACCREDITED INTEGRATED PROFESSIONAL ORGANIZATION FOR ARCHITECTS

WHEREAS, Section 40 of Republic Act No. 9266, otherwise known as the "The Architecture Act of 2004", states:

Sec. 40. Integration of the Architecture Profession. – The Architecture profession shall be integrated into one (1) national organization which shall be accredited by the Board, subject to the approval by the Commission, as the integrated and accredited professional organization of architects. Provided, however, That such an organization shall be registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission, as a non-profit, non-stock corporation to be governed by by-laws providing for a democratic election of its officials. An architect duly registered with the Board shall automatically become member of the integrated and accredited professional organization of architects and shall receive the benefits and privileges provided for in this Act upon payment of the required fees and dues. Membership in the integrated and accredited professional organization of architects shall not be a bar to membership in other associations of architects.

WHEREAS, the Professional Regulation Commission (Commission) issued Resolution No. 1089 (s. 2018) or the "Revised Rules on the Accreditation of Professional Organizations and Integrated Professional Organizations" that provides the guidelines for accreditation of professional organizations;

WHEREAS, the Accredited Integrated Professional Organization (AIPO) accreditation of the UNITED ARCHITECTS OF THE PHILIPPINES, INC. (UAP) expired last 10 May 2021;

WHEREAS, the UAP filed its petition for the issuance of certificate of accreditation, with the following supporting documents:

1. A duly notarized Petition signed by the authorized representative of the professional organization;
2. Secretary's Certificate or Board Resolution granting authority to represent the professional organization;
3. Complete list of incumbent officers of the professional organization, including its chapter officers, with photocopies of their Professional Identification Cards (PICs);
4. Authenticated copy of the latest Certificate of Registration issued by the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC);
5. Authenticated copy of the recent Articles of Incorporation and By-Laws;
6. Authenticated copy of the General Information Sheets for the years 2019, 2020 and 2021;
7. Audited financial statement submitted to SEC duly signed by a Certified Public Accountant authorized to practice public accountancy for the years of 2018, 2019 and 2020;
8. Authenticated copy of the latest Certificate of Registration issued by the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR);
9. Complete list of members in good standing with the association with the following details:
 - a. Name of member in alphabetical order and number;
 - b. Their respective Certificate of Registration numbers;
 - c. Date of registration; and
 - d. State of PIC's whether valid or expired.
10. Report on significant achievements as a corporate body for the years 2018, 2019 and 2020; and
11. Proof of payment of the prescribed processing fee.


WHEREFORE, upon evaluation of the documents submitted, the Professional Regulatory Board of Architecture RESOLVES, as it is hereby RESOLVED, to approve the petition for the issuance of Certificate of Accreditation to the UNITED ARCHITECTS OF THE PHILIPPINES, INC. as the Accredited Integrated Professional Organization for Architects. Pursuant to Resolution No. 1089 (s. 2018), upon granting of the petition, this Resolution shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation. Accreditation shall take effect immediately upon publication thereof and the Commission shall issue the corresponding Certificate of Accreditation.


FURTHER RESOLVED, to reiterate Section 19, Rule 7 of Resolution No. 1089 (s. 2018) which provides for the following:


"Section 19. Cancellation or Suspension of Accreditation. - A certificate of accreditation of an APO/AIPO shall be cancelled or suspended by the PRC or by the concerned Board upon approval or concurrence by the PRC, only after due process, on any of the following grounds/causes:

- a. The APO/AIPO ceases to possess any of the qualifications for accreditation;
- b. The APO/AIPO no longer serves the best interest of the profession for which it was accredited;
- c. The APO/AIPO fails to maintain its membership of fifty percent plus one (50% + 1) of those who have been issued their valid and current PICs;
- d. The APO/AIPO commits acts inimical to the interest of its members and to the profession;
- e. The APO/AIPO fails to submit the annual reportorial requirements as stated under Section 18;
- f. The APO/AIPO fails to exercise legitimate obligations required of them by the Board and/or PRC; and
- g. The APO/AIPO fails to comply with the lawful orders of the Board and/or PRC."



The celebration started with highlighting the architectural heritage and the need to conserve them for the future generation. “As architects, it is our goal to help in pushing for thriving cities while still doing our duty of architectural heritage conservation—one of the greatest manifests of our identity that we are embedded in,” National President Arch. Renato A. Heray said. For UAP, it is vital to educate and inspire architects of today of the built environment of the past. Through its *Sentro Ng Arkitekturang Filipino*, it has been at the forefront of advocating architectural heritage in the country.

The centennial celebration kicked off with an architectural-historical tour in Intramuros, Manila last February 23. Led by UAP and the participants of the Architecture Centennial Coordinating Committee (ACCC), they conducted a historical journey back in time and visited specific sites which are landmarks in the history of the architecture profession.

These are the *Ayuntamiento*, *Intendencia*, and *Mapua University*, all of which are located inside the Walled City. **The Ayuntamiento building** is a historical structure where the City Council or *Cabildo* approved the establishment of the *Escuela Practica de Artes y Oficios*. The school officially created a course for *Maestro de Obras* who were the forerunners of professional architects in the Philippines. **The Intendencia** building is the venue where the

It was honored in the recent ANG SUSI Awards 2019 by the Philippine Council of Associations and Association Executives (PCA AE) during the 7th PCA AE's Association Summit held on November 27, 2019, at the Philippine International Convention Center, Pasay City, Philippines.

UAP was bestowed with the institutional "Outstanding Project Awards" which are given to associations in recognition of their achievements that have made an impact and contribution to national sustainable development and in helping the environment, empowering people, serving communities, enhancing trade and industry, developing technology solutions, and for being an agent of change.

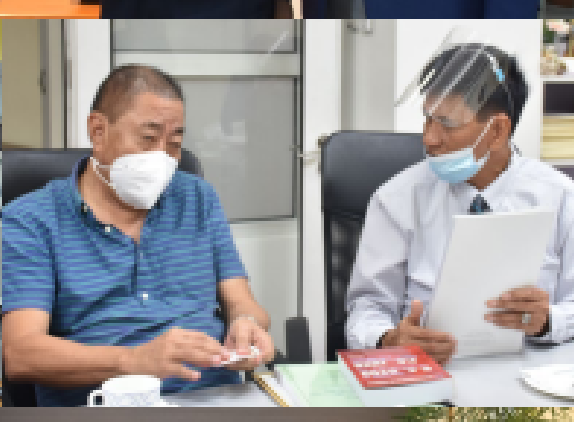
Aside from this, the said advocacy campaign was also honored by the Europe Business Assembly (EBA) in Milan, Italy through its International Achievements Award 2019.

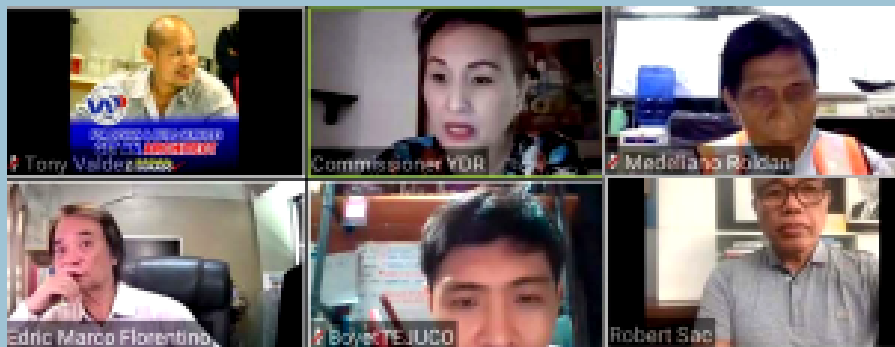

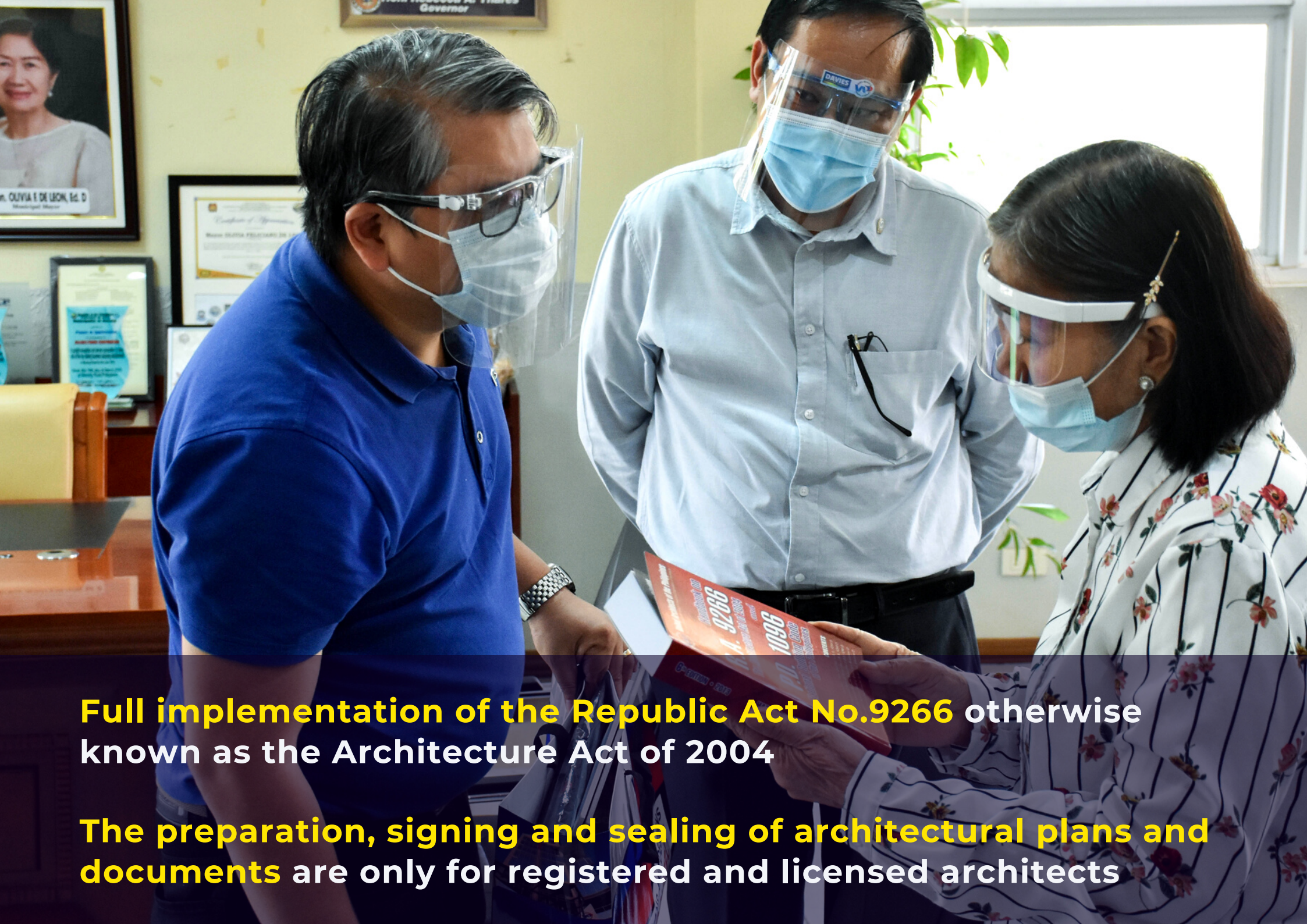
