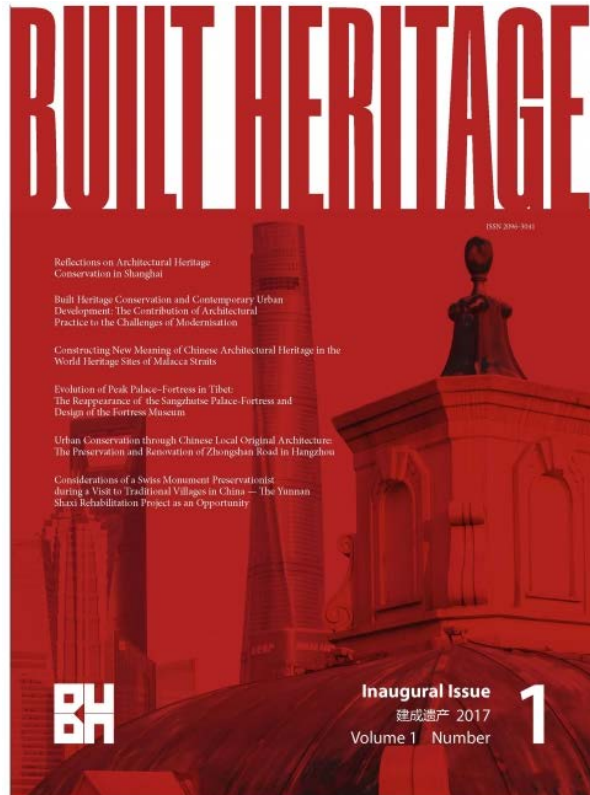
Tongji University, formerly Tongji German Medical School, was established in 1907. It was one of the oldest and most prestigious institutions of higher education in China. Tongji University is one of the leading universities in China under direct administration of Ministry of Education, listed on “Project 985” and “Project 211”. With a history of over a century, Tongji has valued the balanced development of four functions, i.e. education, research, outreach, and culture inheritance and innovation.

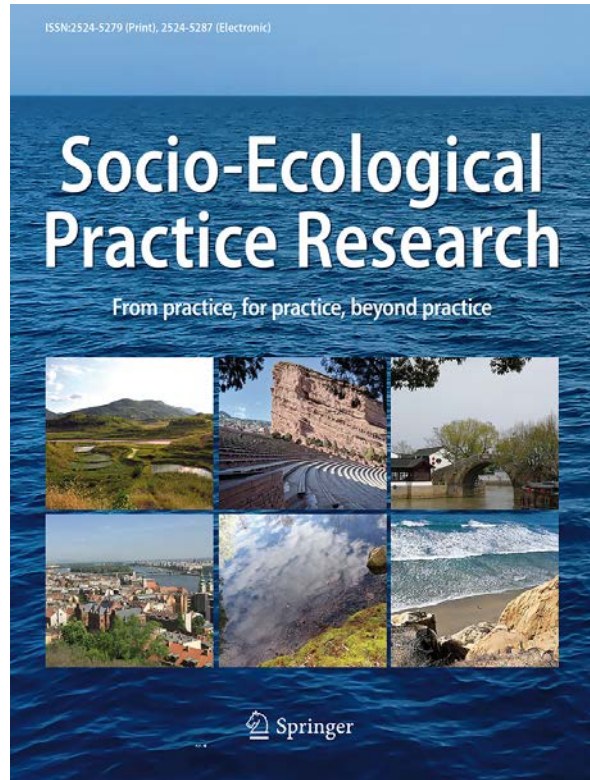

BUILT HERITAGE

Built Heritage is a blind-peer-reviewed, international journal published quarterly, devoted to all aspects regarding the research, conservation, and regeneration of historic buildings, settlements, and sites. It is the first journal in China published in English that integrates built heritage conservation in the multidisciplinary sphere of architecture, urban and rural planning, and landscape architecture, administrated by the Minister of Education of China, sponsored by Tongji University, and published by Tongji University Press. The editor-in-chief Qing CHANG is Professor of the College of Architecture and Urban Planning at Tongji University and an Academician of the Chinese Academy of Sciences. The co-editor-in-chief Jian ZHOU is Professor of the College of Architecture and Urban Planning at Tongji University and the Secretary-General of the World Heritage Institute of Training and Research for the Asia and the Pacific Region under the auspices of UNESCO (WHITRAP). From January 2020, Tongji University Press will initiate a cooperation with the Springer Nature Company as new international publisher of Built Heritage.

SOCIO-ECOLOGICAL PRACTICE RESEARCH

Socio-Ecological Practice Research (SEPR) is the first international journal publishing scholarly articles on transdisciplinary socio-ecological practice research that strives to achieve the dual ambition of producing new knowledge and improving (instead of just informing) ecological practice. SEPR cultivates and celebrates topnotch scholarship in the field of socio-ecological practice research across all four intertwined streams of scholarly inquiry—knowledge (co)production, transfer, implementation, and impact—with a specific focus on knowledge implementation and impact research (i.e., knowledge I&I research).

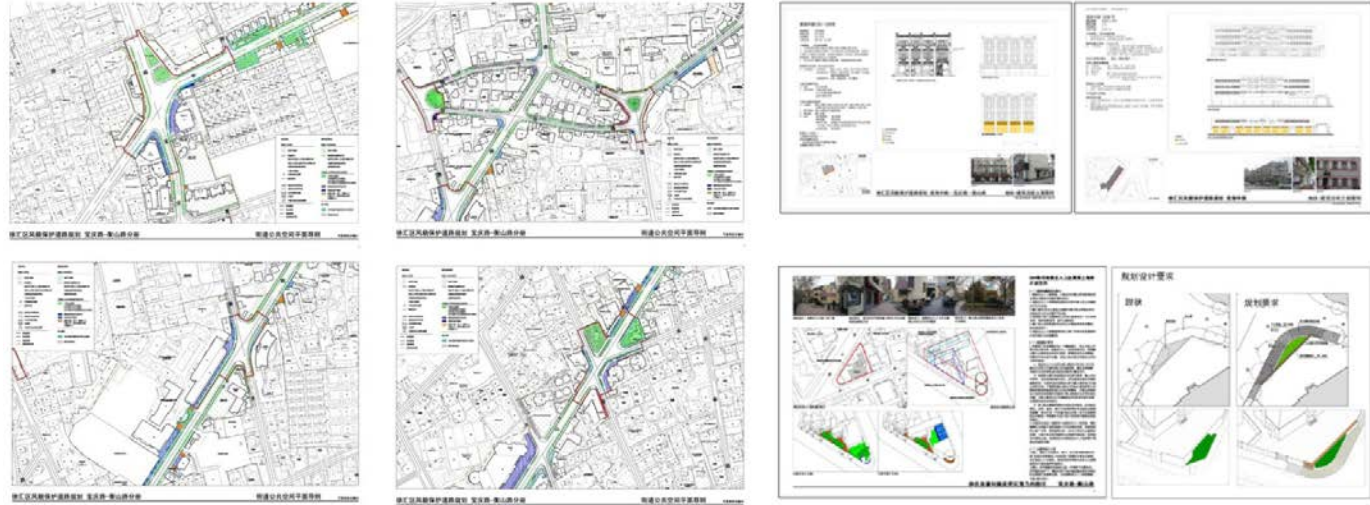

LEADERSHIP & EDUCATOR

As the Standing Council Member of the Architectural Society of China, Vice President of Urban Planning Society of China, as well as the official committee member of the UIA EduCom, he has made immense contributions to the development of Chinese Architecture and urban planning. He has also devoted himself to establishing exemplary global outreach and ties to enhance architectural education in China. As the Executive Vice President of Tongji University, he has led Tongji Architectural School to figure in the top 3 architectural schools in China. As a professor, he has taught architectural design, architectural history and urban design for over 30 years. For the first time in China, new courses on urban study were introduced: *City Reading* for undergraduate students, and *Selected Topics on Chinese Urban Issues* for graduate students. Under his personal supervision, 28 students got their PhD degrees and over 50 students got their Master's degrees.

ADMINISTRATOR & PRACTITIONER

As the former Deputy Director of Shanghai Urban Planning Administration Bureau, he was one of the institutional founders of systematic urban planning and urban design framework. This was aimed at creating a sustainable built environment in Shanghai, by mainly focusing on historical urban areas. For the first time in China, a specific urban planning and design framework was established, in terms of elaborated governance. As the Chief Planner of Shanghai's historical districts, he led a group of planners and architects to plan and design 42 historical districts and 144 historical streets in Shanghai. Furthermore, this framework was extended and developed from the historically sensitive areas to include ecologically sensitive areas, such as the planning and study for Shanghai Chongming Island. Moreover, as a National First Level Registered Architect, he has designed high-quality modern architectural structures, for instance, the Christian Church Pu'antang.

RESEARCHER & PROMOTER

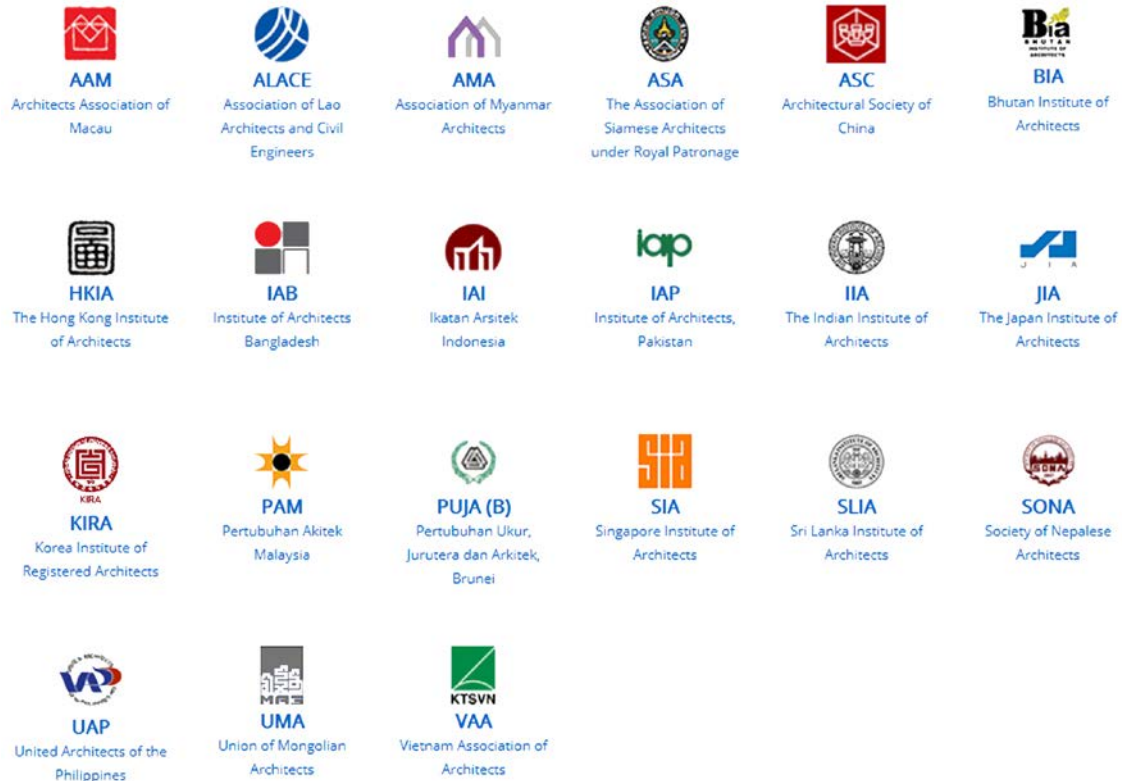
As a professor and scholar, he has done vast research on the development of a sustainable human habitat, by synthesizing historical and theoretical aspects from the perspective of planning and design. His research field includes world architectural history, modern architectural history of China, Chinese contemporary architectural design culture, urbanization of China with sustainable development, urban planning and administrative methodology in China, etc. He has published over a dozen books and has more than 90 papers to his credit. He has given several keynote speeches in international conferences and schools of architecture. He was awarded the title of fellow by the French Academy of Architecture (L'Académie d'Architecture de France) , which is an exceptional honor for a foreigner, for his contribution in representing Chinese culture and architecture abroad.

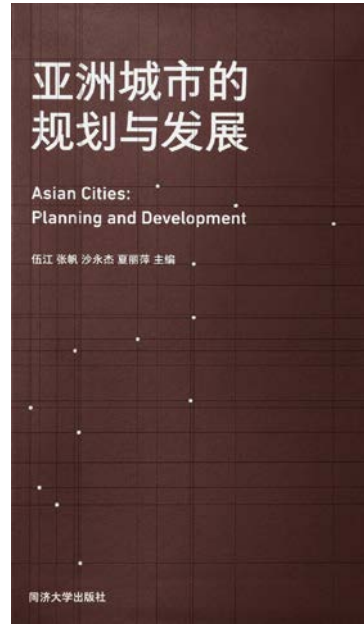



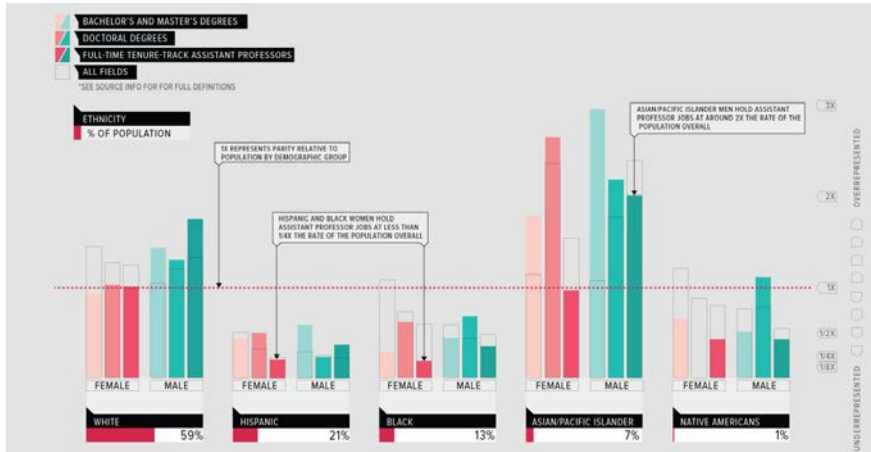
The website of Architecture Asia will give an up-to-date report of the development of Asian architecture and cover the news and activities of Architects Regional Council Asia
