



## **Recommendations of ARCASIA addressed to The Government of Mongolia**

Greetings from the 19-nation Architects Regional Council Asia (ARCASIA), of which UMA has been an active member since 1991.

In support of UMA's quest for promotion of excellence in the architectural profession and the importance of the role of architects in Mongolia's development of the built environment, we the members of ARCASIA cordially recommend that Mongolia adopts provisions of ARCASIA and UIA (International Union of Architects) Accord on Recommended international Standards of Professionalism in Architectural Practice which is also endorsed by UNESCO.

ARCASIA and UIA Accords recognize the strengthening of the role and contribution of architects in the urban planning and development of a country as well as the need to enhance professional accountability and ethics of the professionals.

In order to achieve the above, it is recommended that necessary legislation is put in place to protect the public interest and the development of a socially responsible profession.

As UMA is the sole national representative body of architects in Mongolia, it would be in the nation's interest for UMA to take responsibility in the implementation of the said legislations. For effective enforcement, UMA should undertake the capacity building, professional training and the appropriate accreditation of architects in accordance with initiatives of ARCASIA and UIA
