- **Part one: Report on the first session of ARCASIA Zone C work meeting**

We held the first session of ARCASIA Zone C work meeting in the afternoon of 16th Aug, 2013. All the five member institutes except for Mongolia attended the meeting. Meeting delegates started heated discussions on regional cooperation and exchange, unanimously adopted Zone C work plan and preliminarily consented to conduct academic activities and strengthen communication among Zone C member institutes. The next Zone C meeting will be held in South Korea.

1) In 2013, some entries submitted by Zone C member institutes won the AAA and student competition.

2) To encourage Zone C member institutes to nominate representatives to ARCASIA's four committees and take active part in their activities.

3) To encourage Zone C member institutes to organize more architects and students to attend ARCASIA Forum 17 in Nepal.

•Part three: Affairs in need of ARCASIA's assistance and help:

1) AAA's applicants should be registered members of ARCASIA's member institutes.

2) We suggest the ARCASIA OB meetings could be condensed and operated by modern communication tools such as television or telephone conference to save budget and time. Matters that need studying and researching should be on the OB meeting agenda and general matters should be handled by President Tan Peiing herself.

3) We hope ARCASIA will be more involved in Asia's economic and cultural activities such as UN, APEC and ASEAN and the social influence and status of architects could be further improved accordingly.

4) We suggest to collect ARCASIA member institutes' regulations on architectural education, exam and registration, architectural practice and continuing education to edit Handbook for Asian Architects to facilitate their communication.
