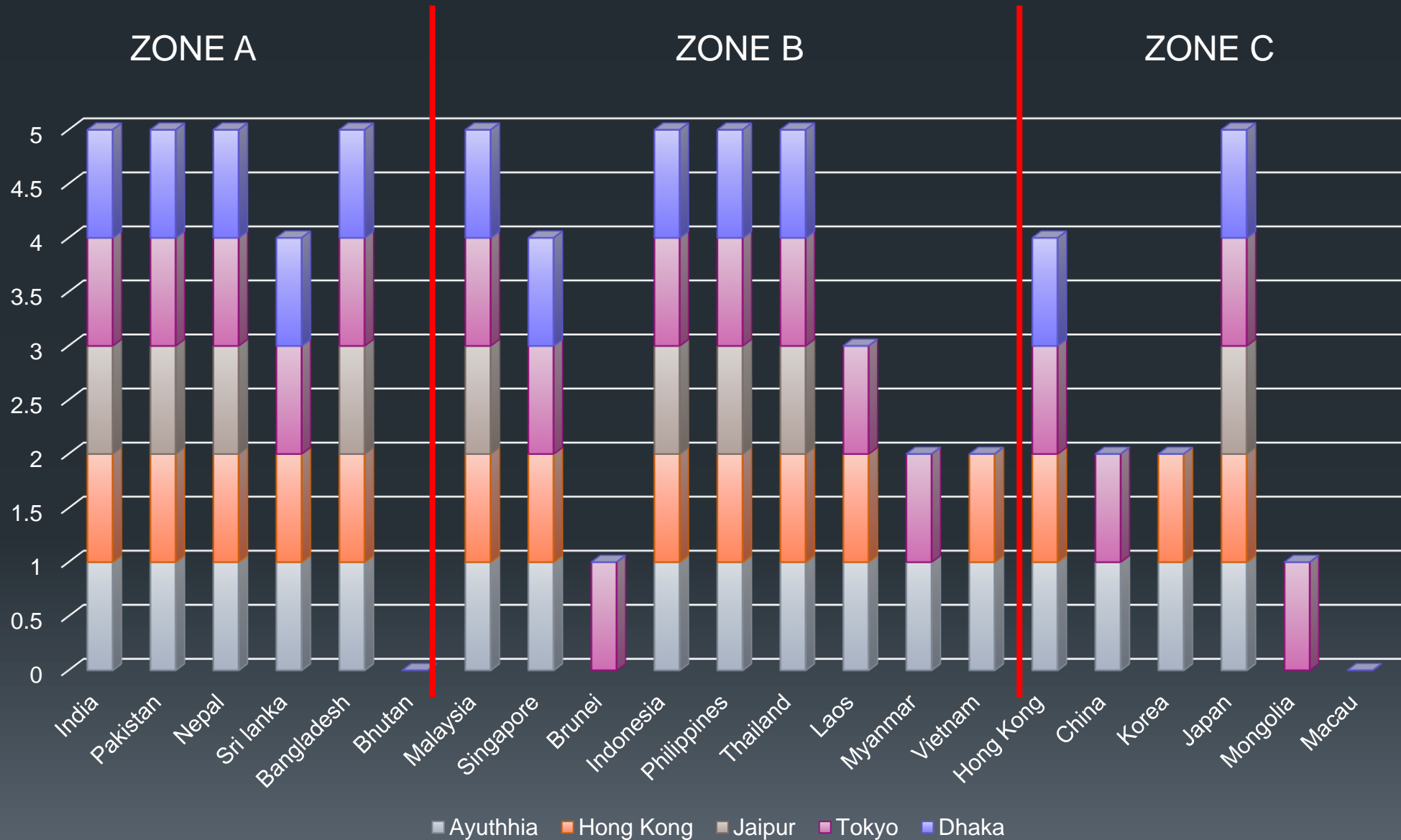

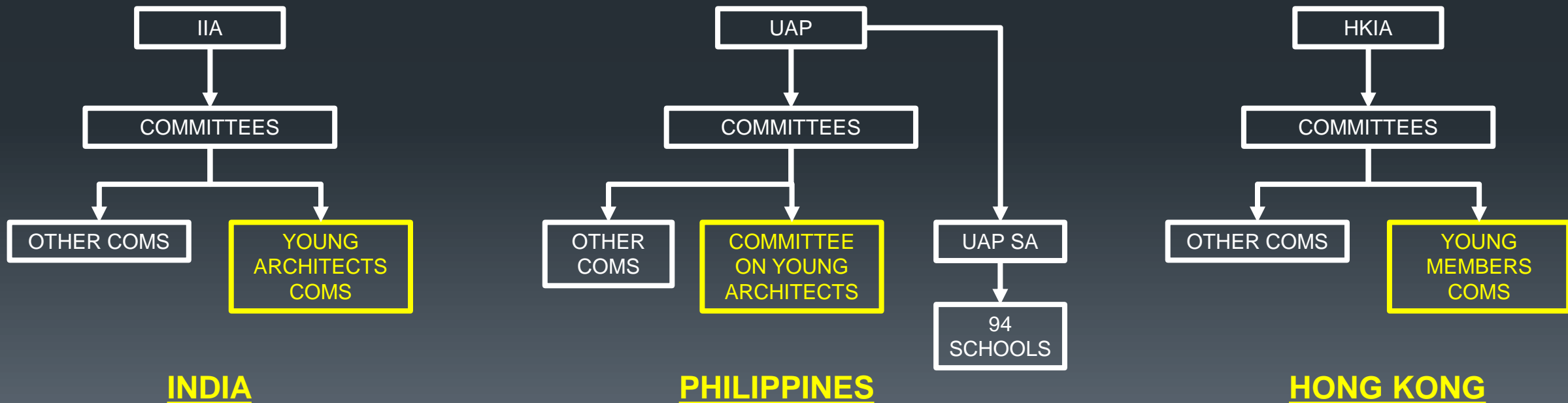
SHARING OF YOUTH COUNTRY FRAMEWORK 2018

INTRODUCTION
VIDEO GAME INDUSTRY
