4.3 How to share and learn from each Institutes Programmes on Cultural Heritage and Historic Conservation.

4.4 How to share each Institutes Programmes on Green and Sustainable Architecture and Social Responsibility Architecture.

4.5 How can the more “develop Institutes” help the “developing Institutes” become stronger. Perhaps help establish Bi-lateral assistance between Institutes, for example KIRA may want to help ALACE, etc.

4.6 How will ARCASIA be positioned in the International Scene.

5.0 The Meeting

5.1 Closed Door Session
