

Architecture Asia Awards for Emerging Architecture

Aims

1. To promote emerging Asian architects and their works.
2. To provide a platform for discourse on emerging Asian architecture.
3. To provide a ready and authoritative reference for current Asian Architecture.

(Sub-aims)

1. To provide Architecture Asia with a steady supply of projects for publication.
2. To provide ARCASIA member countries a readily supply of conference speakers.
3. To generate income to sustain Architecture Asia through the Awards entry fees and sponsorships plus the increase in advertising revenue arising from the Awards.

ENTRY RULES AND REGULATIONS, PROEDURES, AND CRITERIA

Online Registration, Payment and Submission (Register your details online)

Submit your US\$150 payment online.

Submit your entry online.

Eligibility

Architects, and people in other design professions whose qualifications are recognised by their local accreditation organisation, provided that they are 45 years or younger in the year of the Award are eligible to enter.

Completed work

The AA Awards for Emerging Architects celebrate excellence in completed work. Entries can be made for any building, interior, landscape, urban or product design.

Categories

Categories will only be decided by the Jury from the entries received. Entries could include but not limited to the following areas:

Buildings - new and refurbishment: offices, shops, schools, houses, housing, industrial, transport, restaurants, recreational, cultural, municipal and religious. **Interiors** - new and refurbishment: similar to building category, in particular restaurants, shops, houses, clubs and galleries. **Urban design** Street furniture - lights, bus stops, bollards, signs and post boxes **Product design** - light fittings, furniture, cladding and structural systems. **Landscape** - soft and hard **Bridges** Temporary or portable structures - exhibition stands **Theatre works**

Judging Criteria

Architects

- 1) AA Emerging Asia Architect Award
- 2) AA Emerging Architect Award

Apart from Awards for buildings, the AA Awards also give recognition to emergent architects.

Age restriction

The age limit of 45 has been set on the basis that many emerging architects are unable to realise designs or develop an original vision before that time, whether because of the long education and training period, or because of lack of opportunity.

Winning Entries

Publication

Winners and highly commended entries will be published in the December issue of The Architecture Asia magazine and website www.architectureasia.co

Awards ceremony

The Awards ceremony will be held in Kuala Lumpur or the city where the ARCASIA Conference is hosted. All winners will be invited to the event. Everyone who enters is welcome to join us to discover our winners and commended entries and to launch the start of the Aa Emerging Architecture exhibition.

Lecture Series

Some of the winners and highly commended entrants will be invited to present their projects at the annual Datum KL and ARCASIA Conference, alongside many well respected architects. ARCASIA member countries are also encouraged to invite the winners to speak at their national conferences.

Exhibitions

Winning and other highly commended entries will be exhibited at the Awards ceremony in Kuala Lumpur or at the ARCASIA Conference and at subsequent exhibitions (schedule to be announced).

Entry Requirements

You may submit as many entries as you like, and each entry should show only ONE project.

Submission

Each entry should be composed on two A2 sized boards and email the boards in high resolution PDF format to the email address.

Judging Criteria

- 1) Creative, innovative, cutting edge and refreshing design.
- 2) Green and sustainable.
- 3) Significant contribution to architectural design and technology.
