At Present, the pictogram with wheelchair logo represents 'disabled toilet'. Most of us wondered if that represents 'all the disabled', or just wheelchair users. So the objective of this design is to create the 'enabled public toilet' that could be accessed by everybody regardless of the divisions of 'able/disabled' or others.

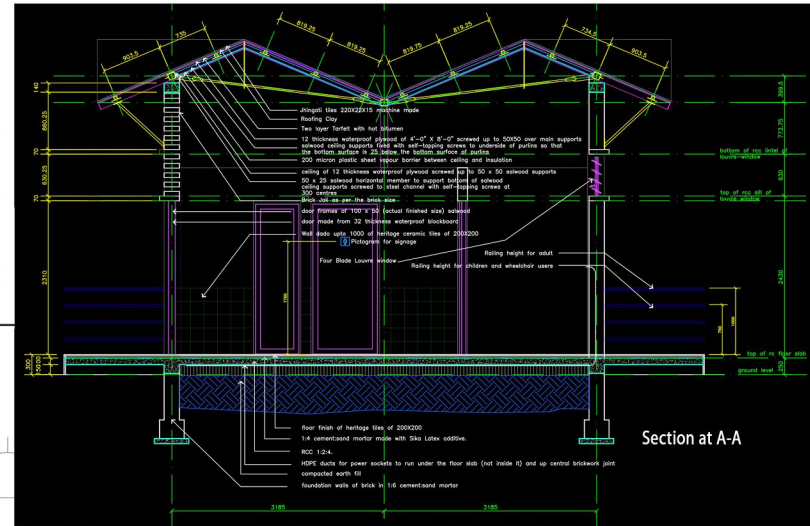
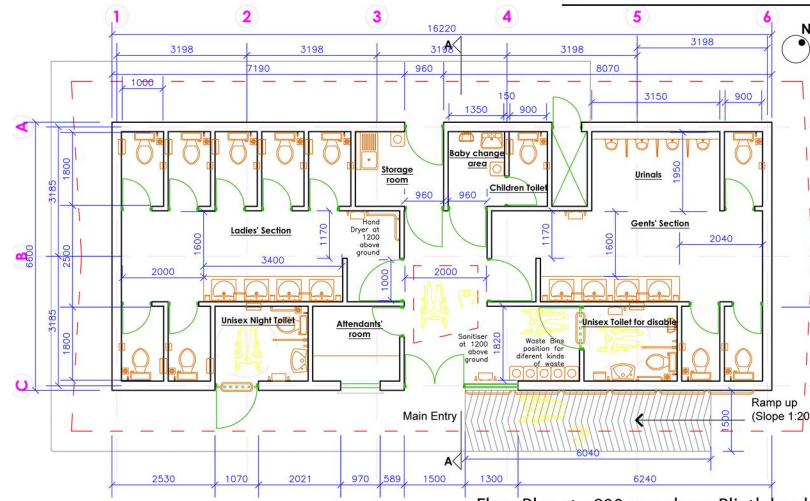
