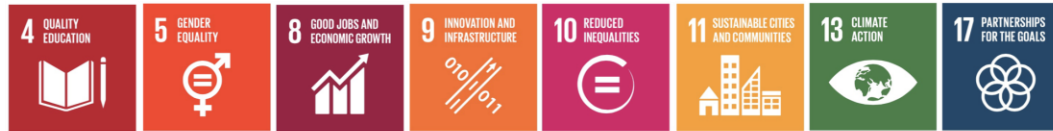
is to bring ACYA as a **BRIDGE** for the promotion of as many young architects as possible in all member institutes by empowering them with support, and relatable knowledge.

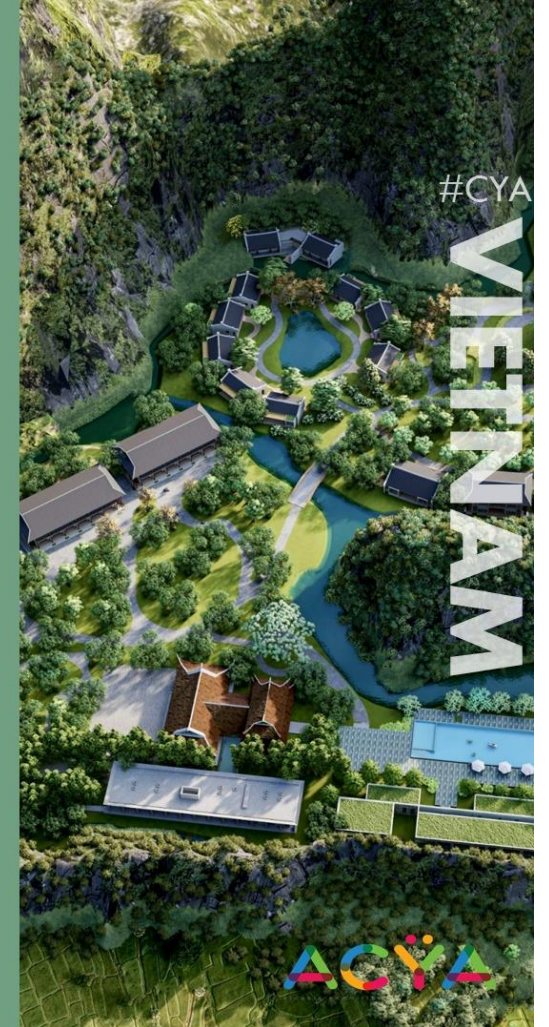

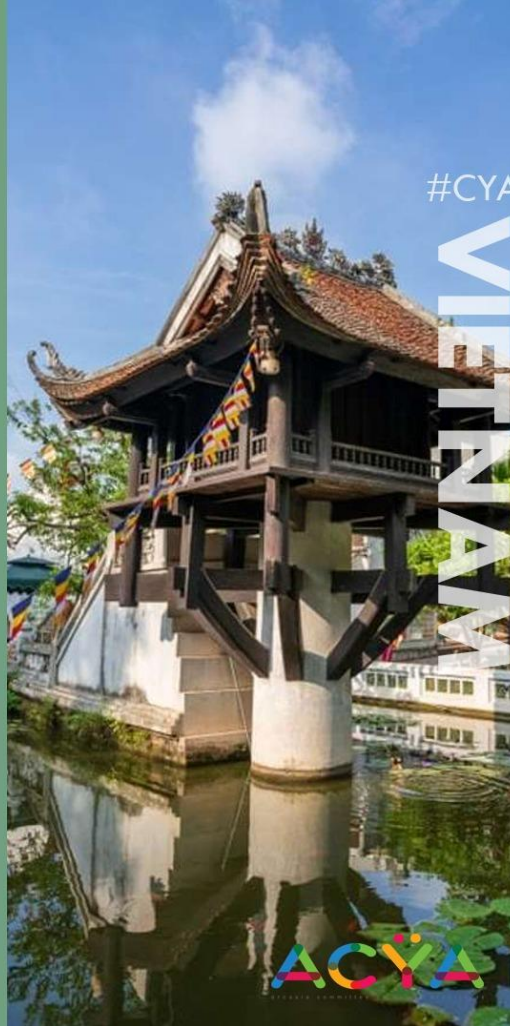
