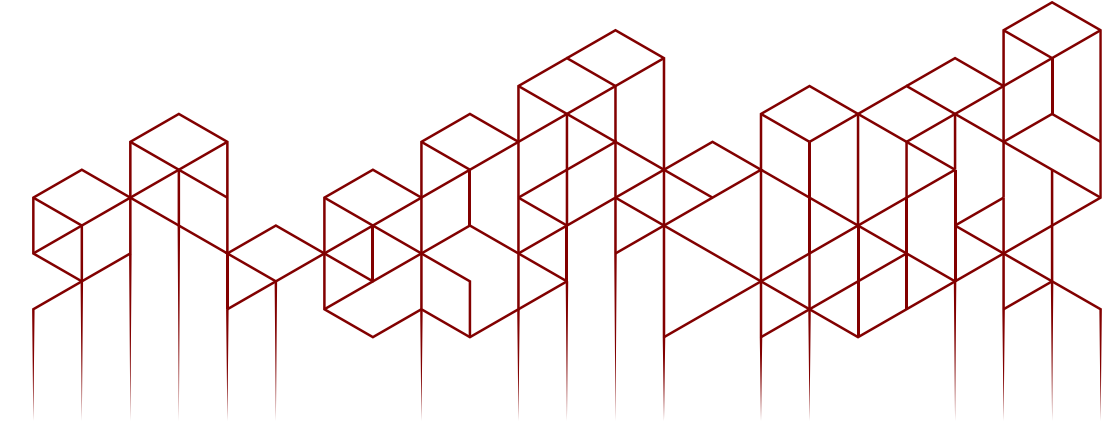

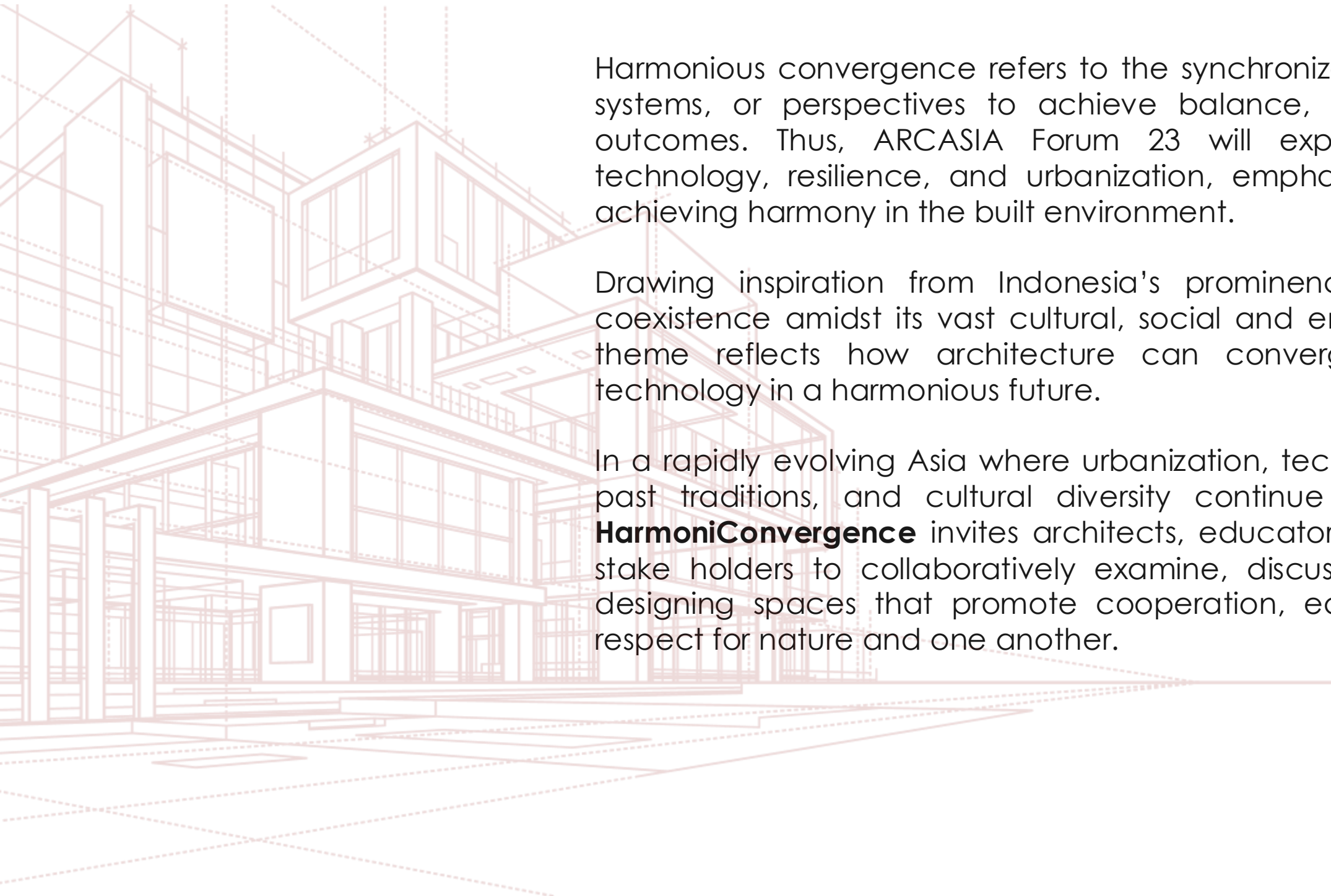


HARMONIC CONVERGENCE

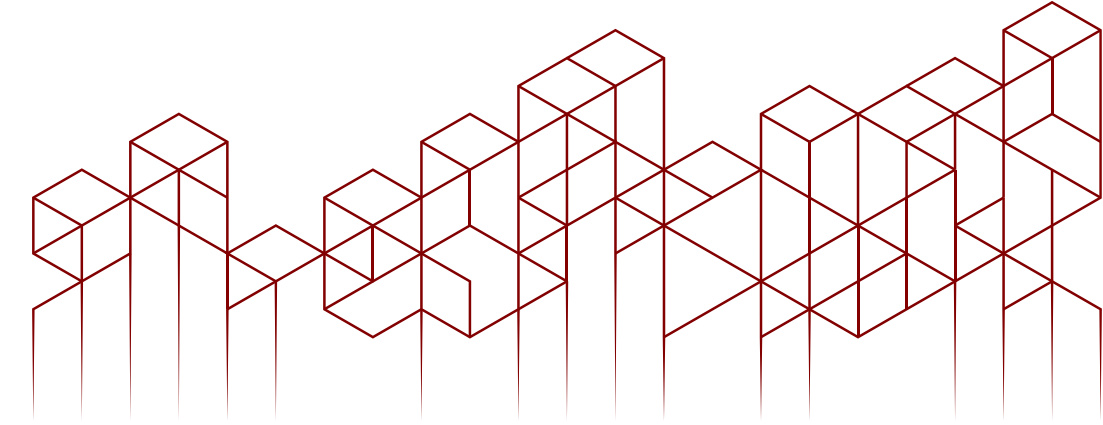

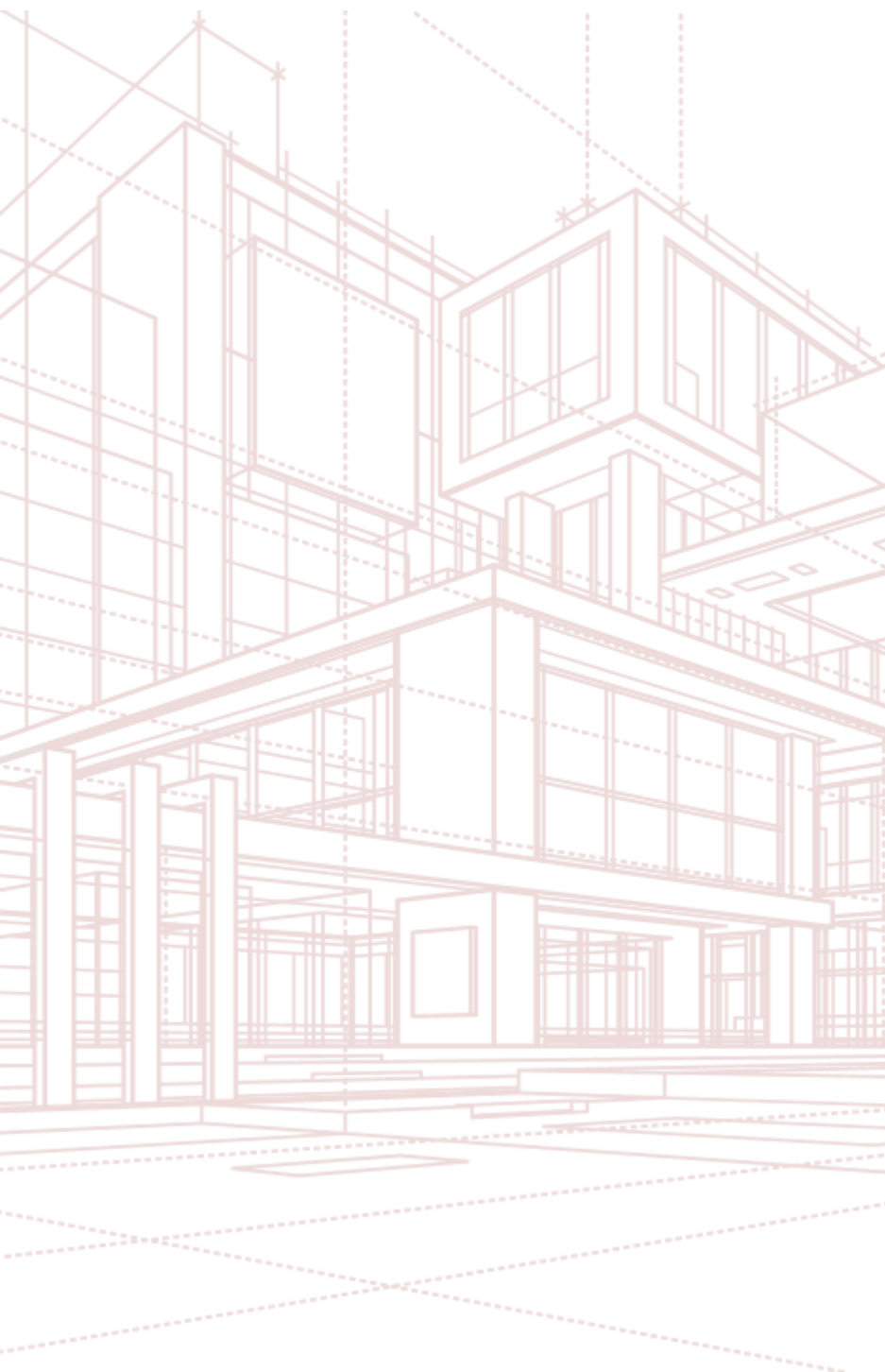
(ARCASIA Committee on Architectural Education – ACAE)

Here, architectural education will be discussed, encouraging curricula that integrate diverse perspectives and foster an understanding of global, cultural, and environmental contexts in design.

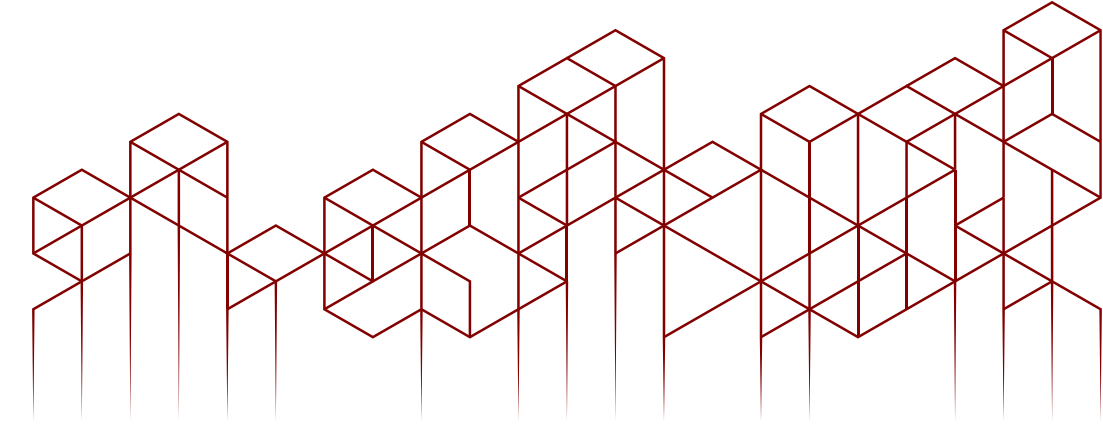
