## Assistance By IAB During Climatic Disasters

IAB Stands by Flood Victims of Feni and Comilla in Record-Breaking Flood of 2024. Under the Social Responsibility Committee of IAB, a sub-committee in the first phase distributed relief materials including rice, lentils, and other essential items to 100 families in various areas of Fulgazi Upazila, Feni. In the second phase, 100 boxes of relief were distributed in Comilla.

Architects of Bangladesh swiftly mobilized to reach the remotest corners of the flood-stricken areas, delivering food, medical care, and vital assistance to those in desperate need.

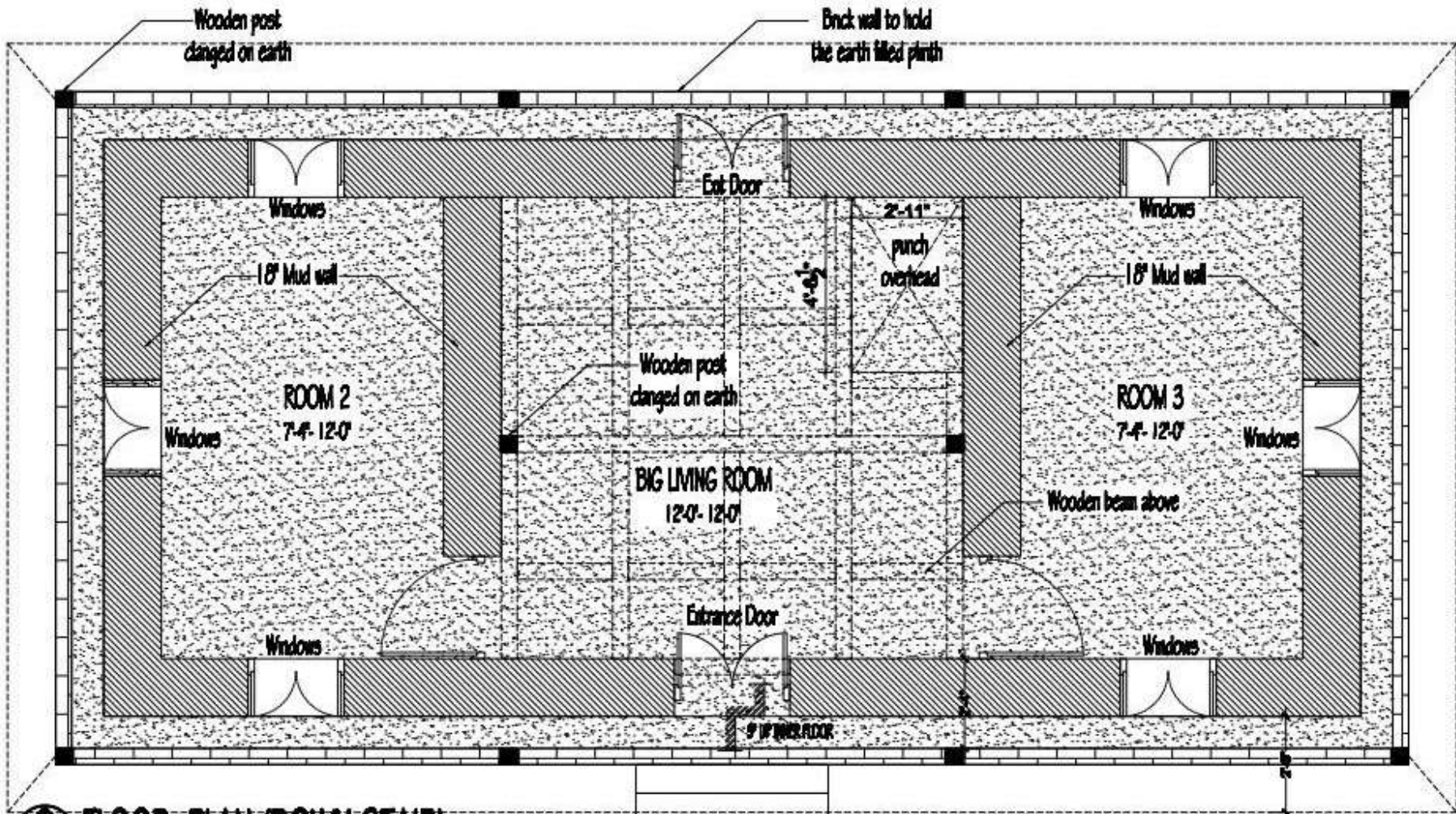

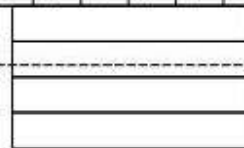
# Flood Resilient House Building Project of IAB In Feni & Noakhali

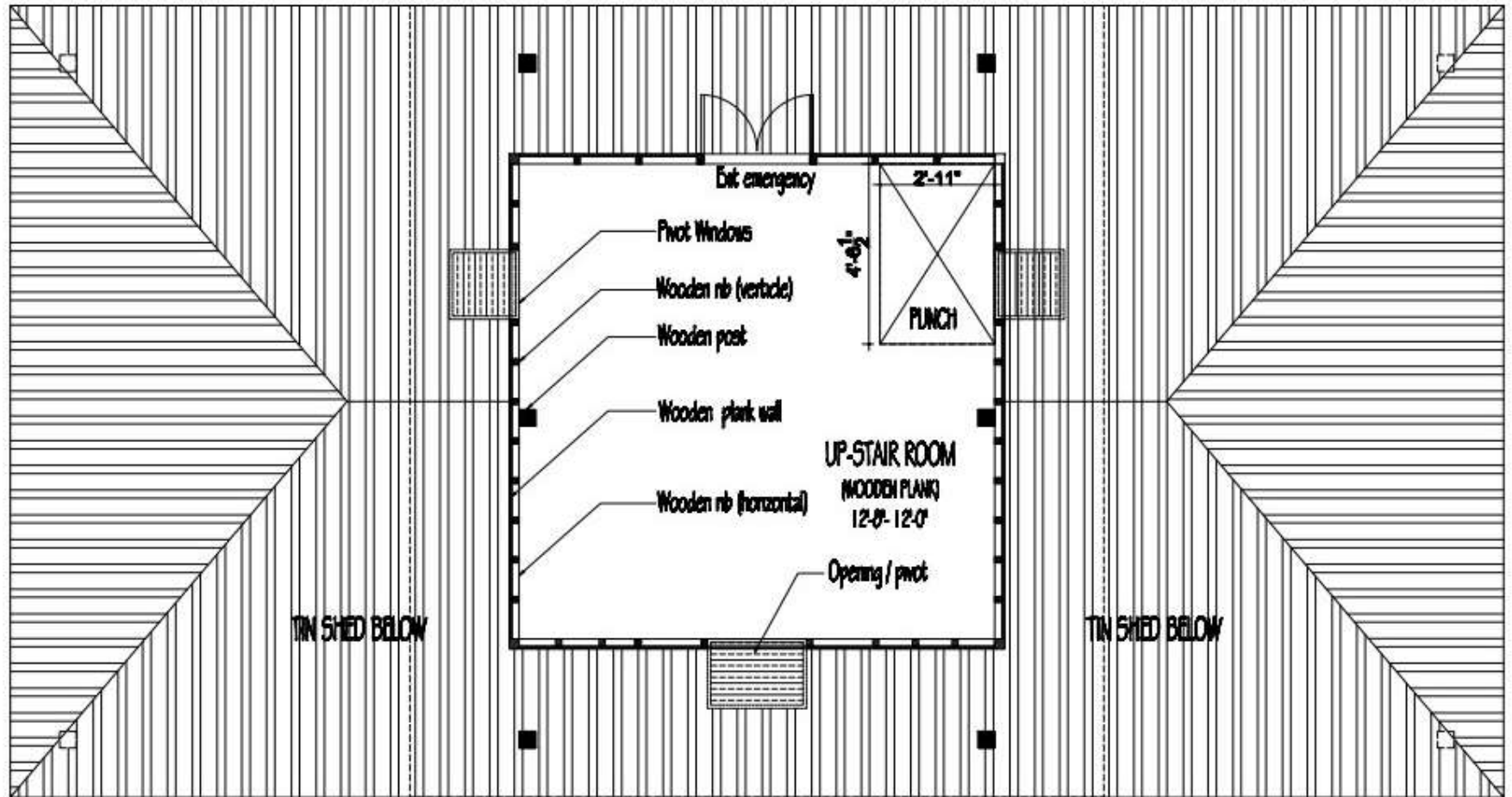


Bangladesh is a flood-prone country, with none of its rivers originating within its borders, making flood control highly dependent on complicated international collaboration. Therefore, after the floodwaters receded, architects proposed innovative ideas for designing flood-resilient houses in the affected areas. As part of a design exercise, six such houses are currently under construction in 2 different regions.

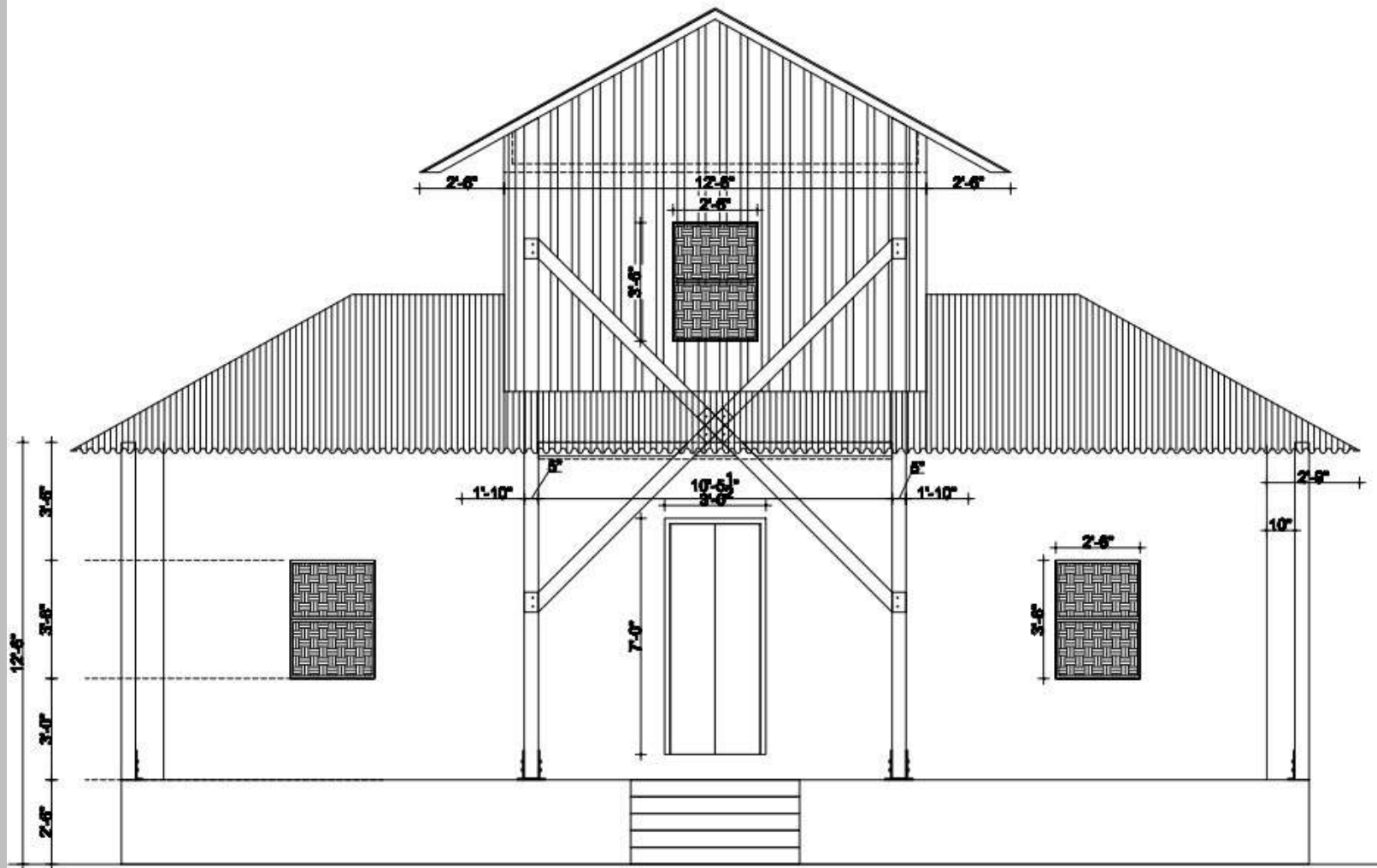


 **FLOOR PLAN (DOWN STAIR)**

Many houses in bhola were completely damaged by this cyclone but none of our houses were damaged due to our newly introduced anchorage system, Alhamdulillah

**Story of the House of Rahima Bibi**

I'll end with the story of Rahima Bibi, a middle-aged woman abandoned by her husband years ago and this was the condition of her house.



And this is her new house with total legal ownership to her built under our programme







The man smiling beside Rahima Bibi is that mysterious lost husband, who abandoned her years ago but has now returned from Dhaka after she received her new house. This is a testament to how architecture can transform lives, empowering women like Rahima within their families and communities, fostering dignity and hope.

So far we have built 42 such houses in different parts of Bangladesh and presently 7 houses are under construction.....and still a long way to go.

IAB is establishing its overseas Chapters and Centres. Already Canada Chapter and UK Centre have been formed. USA chapter and Australia Chapter is under formation.

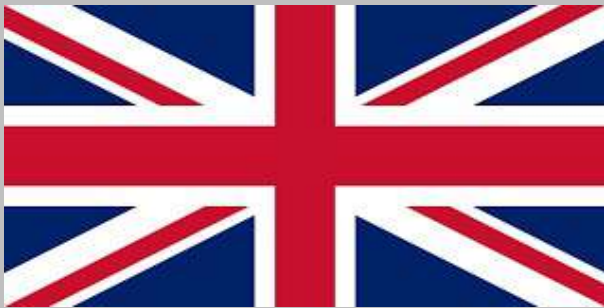

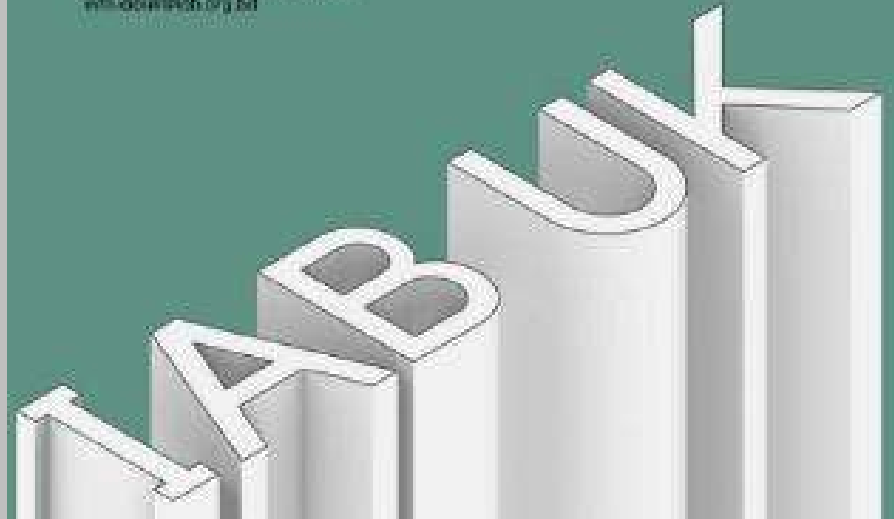

### **Sending Representatives to the Design Approval Committee**

There is a mandatory requirement for IAB representatives in the building/structure design approval committees in 4 city corporations, 325 municipalities, and Upazila Parishads that fall outside the jurisdiction of the development authority. IAB has formed a sub-committee for the oversight of building design and construction. This sub-committee works under the local government division to improve the building design approval process and enhance the standards of architectural practice in city corporations, municipalities, and Upazila Parishads.
