GREEN BUILDING INITIATIVE (GBI)

Green Building Index (GBI) is Malaysia's leading green rating tool, established in 2009 by Pertubuhan Akitek Malaysia (PAM) and the Association of Consulting Engineers Malaysia (ACEM). As the green arm of PAM, GBI plays an advisory role to the Arcasia Committee on Green & Sustainable Architecture (ACGSA), supporting regional collaboration in sustainable design. GBI promotes environmental responsibility through 18 specialised tools covering residential, commercial, industrial, and niche sectors including data centres and hospitals. Guided by the taglines "Greening Malaysia One Building At A Time" and "Malaysia's International Green Benchmark", GBI recently launched the Data Centre Tool and celebrated a major milestone: over 300 million sqft of certified green buildings—a testament to Malaysia's growing green transition.

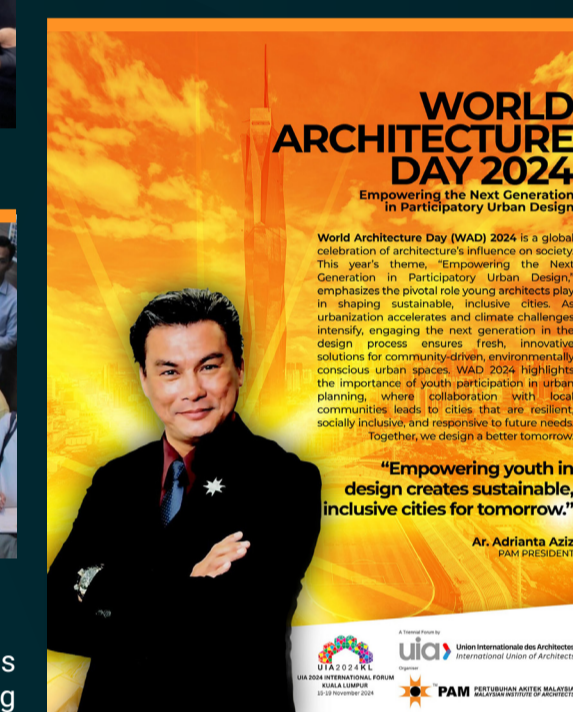
ARCHIDEX

PAM was Founded in 1923 as the Institute of Architects Malaya, its name was changed in 1948 to the Federation of Malaya Society of Architects (FMSA), then allied to the Royal Institute of British Architects (RIBA). Another change to its current name to reflect national sovereignty came about on 20th January, 1967 when PAM was registered with the Registrar of Societies.

PAM mission statement is "To promote the advancement of architecture and the architectural profession for the betterment of society"

PAM currently has approximately 5,000 members consisting of professional architects, graduates and students. Apart from its registered address in the capital city, PAM membership is also represented across Malaysia with member chapters in Sabah, Sarawak, Penang (Northern chapter), Johore Baru (Southern chapter) and East Coast.

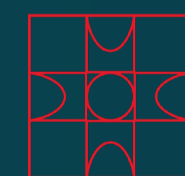
The PAM Centre, a Green Building Index Platinum-rated tropical office, has natural ventilation and vertical plants, highlighting its attractive and cost-effective design.
