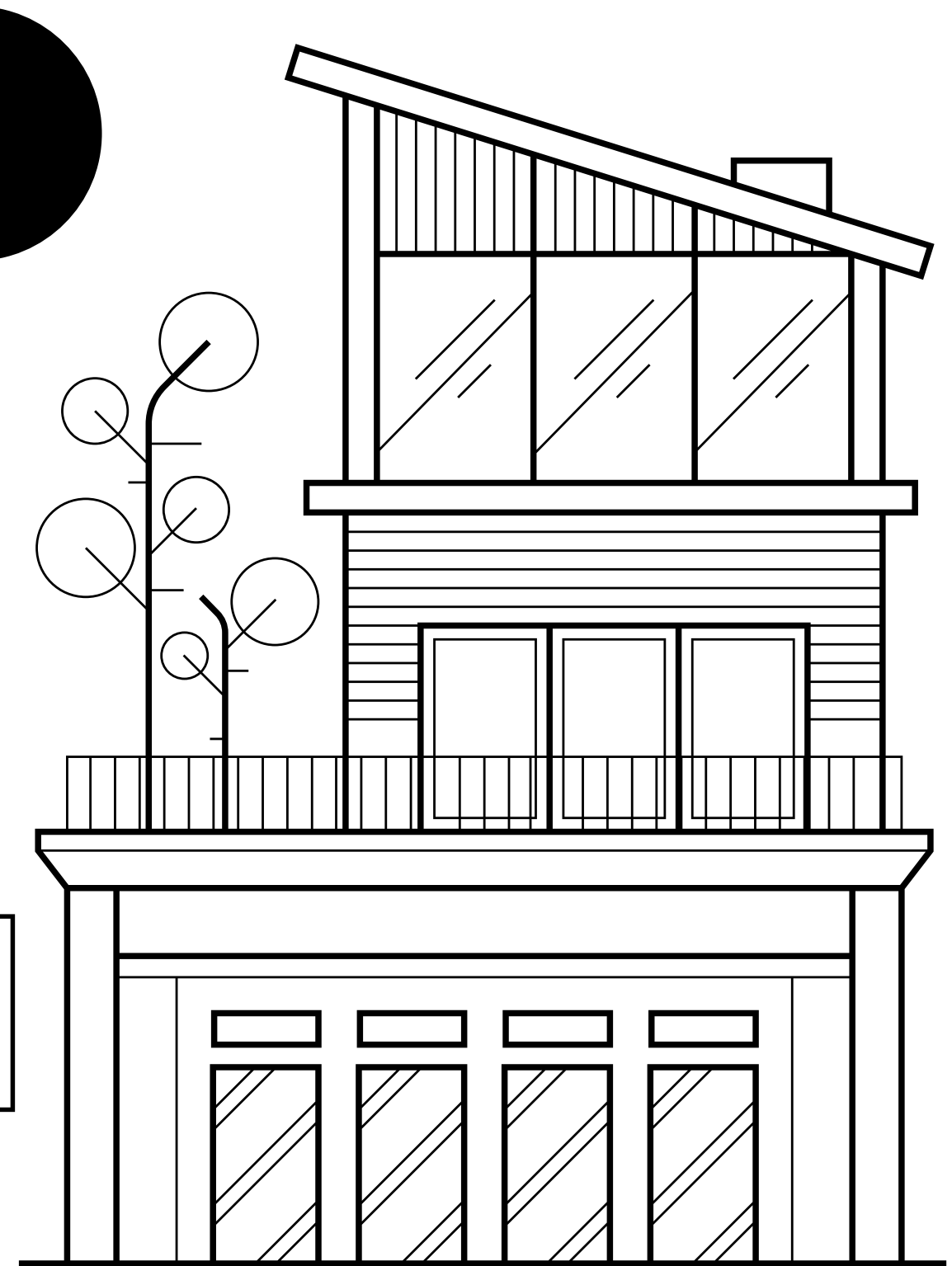
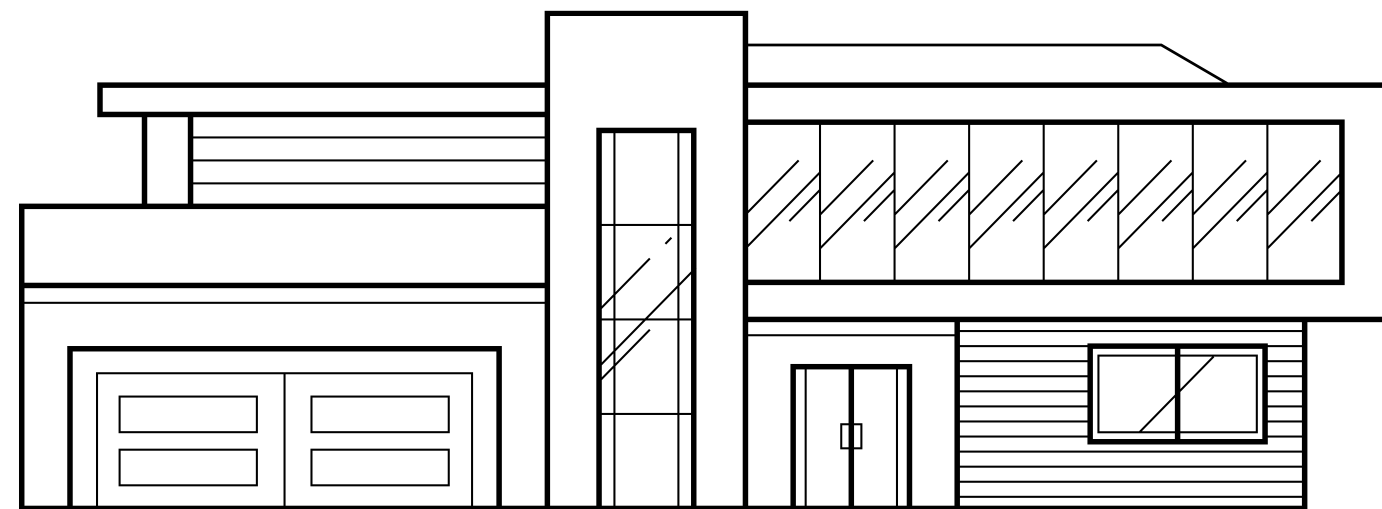


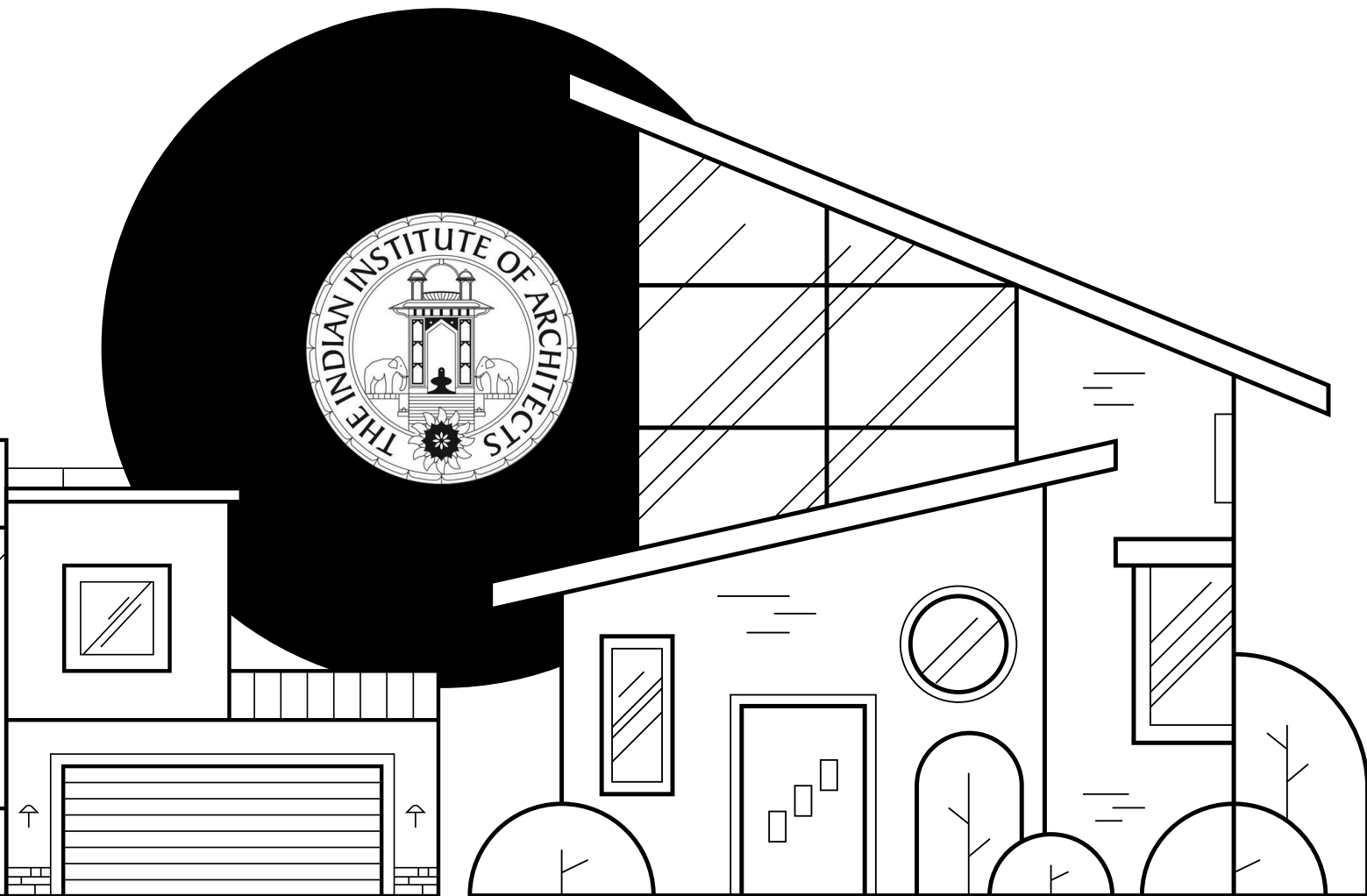

ANCIENT LEGACY

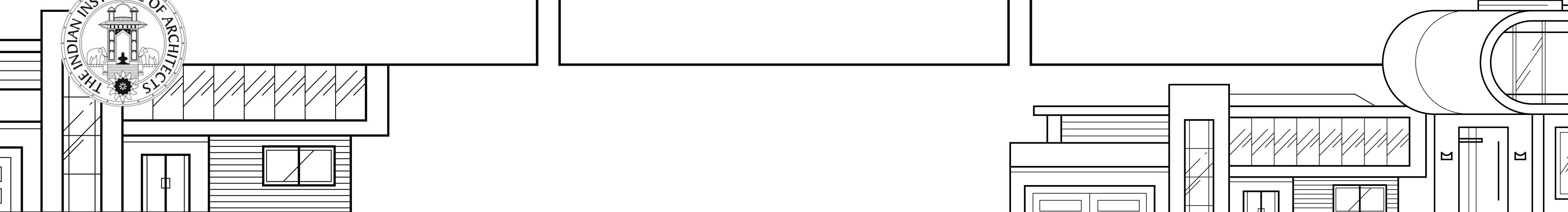

TRADITIONAL PRINCIPLES:

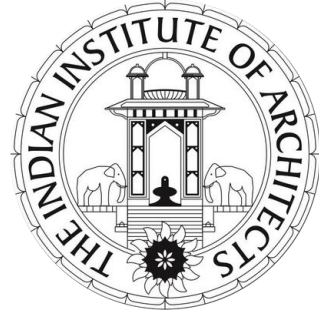

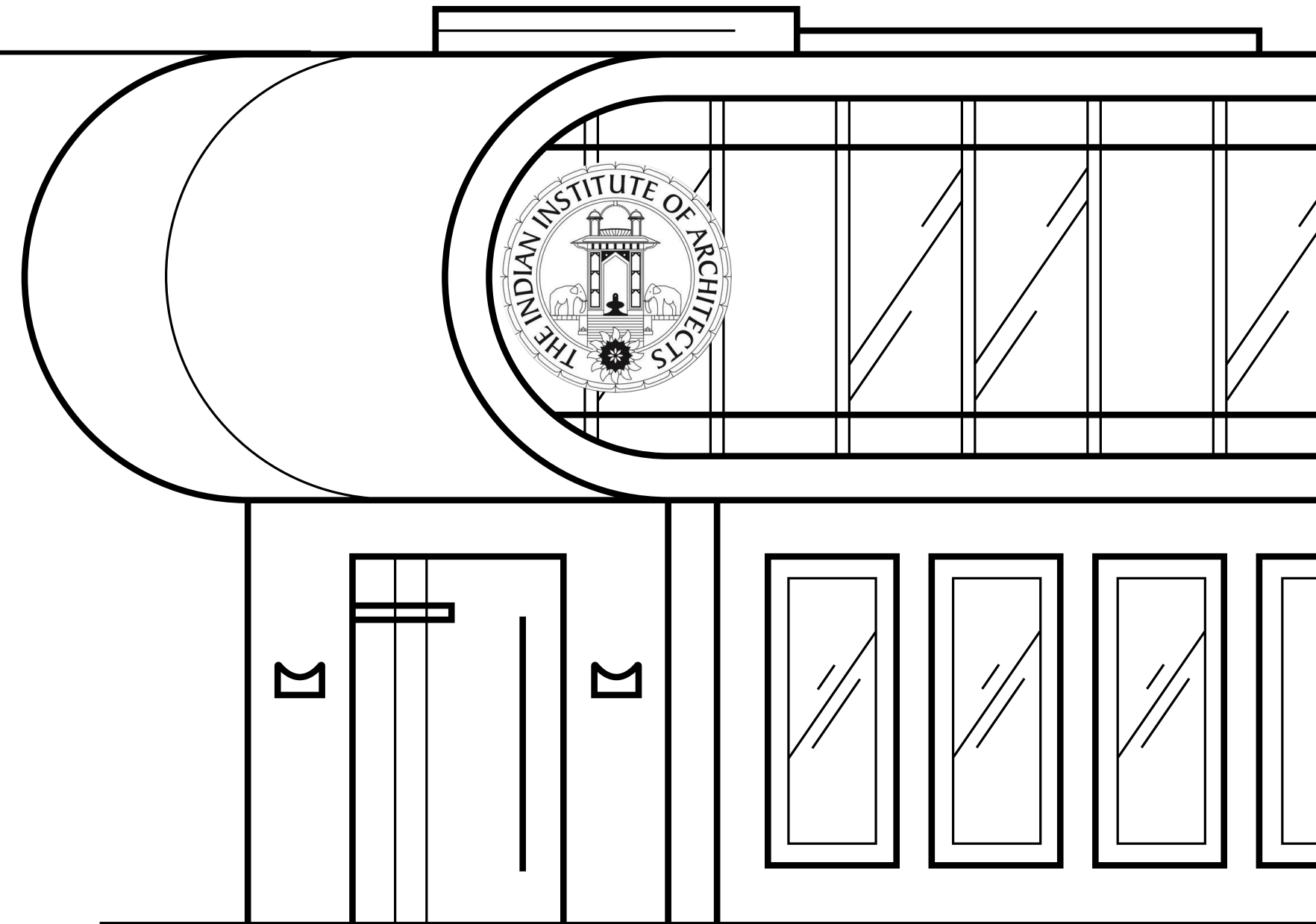
Economic Value of Architecture in India
